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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students at the 11th or 12th grade level with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average are eligible to take dual enrollment courses at Saginaw Valley State University. Students below that level must be approved on a case-by-case basis.

Up to three classes may be taken each semester with the approval of the high school and Saginaw Valley's Office of Admissions.

Students must earn at least a "C" grade in each class if they wish to continue taking dual enrollment courses at Saginaw Valley State University.

Students who demonstrate ability to be successful in courses with established prerequisites may have the prerequisite requirement waived.

All dual enrollment paperwork must be turned in and processed, prior to the first day of the semester, in which you wish to enroll. No dual enrollment registrations will be accepted after the semester has begun.
