Jenny Prior - Saginaw Valley State

Saginaw Valley State University senior forward Jenny Prior scored her first goal of the match in the 88th minute to tie the score with Saint Joseph's College at 2-2. Then in overtime she scored her second goal to give SVSU a 3-2 win. Prior's efforts lifted the Cardinals season record to 2-1. She leads her squad this season in goals (3), points (seven), shots (22), and shots-on-goal (13).

GLIAC Women's Soccer Notes

Ashland - The Eagles earned a split at their home invitational over the weekend, posting a 3-0 win over Missouri-St. Louis (9/10) and falling 1-0 to SIU-Edwardsville (9/12). The loss to SIUE halted a pair of impressive streaks for AU. Ashland had been on a 17-match (15-0-2) home unbeaten streak, dating back to the start of the 2002 campaign. The Eagles' regular season home unbeaten streak ended at 48 (45-0-3). Ashland's last home regular season loss was a 4-0 defeat against Oakland (MI) in 1997. The Cougars have had Ashland's number in recent years. AU has lost just three regular season contests since the start of the 2002 season and all three defeats have come at the hands of SIUE.

Ferris State - The Bulldogs have scored two or more goals in four consecutive outings to date this campaign... Sophomore goalkeeper Carla Gilbertson (Waunakee, Wis.) tied Connie Bigott (2000-01) for the second-most wins in the program's history with Saturday's (Sept. 11) shutout of Northern Kentucky. Gilbertson, who has a current career mark of 10-7-1, has two shutouts in her last three outings to date this season... The Bulldogs have been out shot in all seven of their outings to date this campaign. FSU has also committed more fouls than its opponent in five of its seven contests this year.

Findlay - The Oilers got two wins over the weekend to win the Oilers Invitational after beating Concord 3-1 on Saturday and West Virginia Wesleyan 2-1 on Sunday... Jessica Booth led the charge by scoring two goals in the win over Concord... Megan Innes chipped in with Findlay's third goal... In the Oilers 2-0 win over West Virginia Wesleyan in the championship game, Innes had an assist on a Molly Monter goal to open the scoring then chipped in with a goal to solidify the Oilers win.

Gannon - The Lady Knights matched their win total from a year ago in just their fourth game, posting a 2-1 victory over visiting California (Pa.). Last season, it took Gannon 11 games to grab victory number two, en route to a 2-16 mark. Alison Mabery (Lapeer, Mich./ East) scored her first collegiate goal against the Lady Vulcans and Tami Hyziewicz (McKean, Pa./ General McLane) converted the game-winner.

Grand Valley State - The Lakers ended their four-game road stint against Great Lakes Regional opponents by going 1-1 this past weekend... Junior forward Mirela Tutundzic recorded three goals in the two games for GVSU... She now

has second goals on the season and has scored one goal in five out of six Laker matches... Shannon Carrier and Kristi Vandeberghe both added their second goal of the season... Second year head coach Dave DiIanni has tallied a 21-4-2 record with a .815 winning percentage... The Lakers only play one match this week as they host Indianapolis on Wednesday at the GVSU Soccer Field.

Mercyhurst - Sophomore GK Karen Eade (Burlington, Ontario/Burlington Central) made a combined 28 saves in a 1-2 week. Eade made 13 in the double overtime win over SIUE to get her third shutout of the season... Sophomore forward Lisa Casement (Mississauga, Ontario/Erindale Secondary School) celebrated her first contest of the season with the game-winner against SIUE... Mercyhurst will christen its new artificial grass field Wednesday when it entertains West Virginia Wesleyan.

Northern Michigan - NMU did not play any matches last week... This week the 'Cats will have a swing through West Virginia with matches against Davis & Elkins, West Virginia Tech and West Virginia Wesleyan... The 2-0-1 start is the best start for a season for the 'Cats since they started the 1998 and 2001 seasons with a 3-0-0 mark.

Northwood - Northwood posted its first tie of the 2004 season, earning a draw with Saint Joseph's ... the Timberwolves once again received goals from Ashleigh Lynn and Amy Snyder ... Snyder and Lynn have each scored five goals this season - the rest of the team has combined for one goal ... Lynn got Northwood on the board with the first goal of the game at the 22:26 mark, while Snyder's goal came at the 66:55 mark to tie the game ... Northwood was ranked ninth in the inaugural regional poll of the 2004 season ... the Timberwolves are one of five GLIAC teams earning rankings in week one ... the Timberwolves have a nine-day break after their match with Aquinas.

Saginaw Valley State - SVSU outshot Saint Joseph's 26-12 on Sat. (Sept. 11)... The Cards improved to 2-1 on the season after beating Saint Joseph's on Sat. (Sept. 11)... on the season SVSU has outshot opponents 85-21... the Cards have registered 40 shots on goal this season, while their opponents have only 12.
