– PLAYER NOTES –

• BRIGGS' HOUSE

Freshman **Kali Briggs** (*Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake*) recorded her eighth double-figure game in rebounds with 13 boards against Mercyhurst (Jan. 6). That total included a career-high 10 offensive rebounds. Her 16 points completed her fourth double-double of the season.

- Briggs has maintained her lead in the GLIAC with 11.8 rebounds per game.
- She currently ranks fifth in NCAA Division II in rebounds per game.

• DROP IT LIKE IT'S HOT

Senior guard **Jessica Wilson** (*Martin, Tenn./Westview*) is leading the GLIAC in three-point field goals per game (2.73) and is on pace to break the SVSU single season record for three-point field goals. The record is currently held by Michelle Aerts, who hit 60 triples during the 1994-95 season.

- Wilson currently ranks 26th in NCAA Division II in three-point field goals per game.

• GIVE AND TAKE

Sophomore guard **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) is leading the team in both scoring (14.7ppg) and assists (4.73apg). She ranks in the top ten in the GLIAC in both categories, holding the ninth spot in scoring and ranking third in assists.

- Bilunes' assist per game average ranks 43rd overall in NCAA Division II.

• CONNECT FOUR

The Cardinals currently have four players averaging double figures in the scoring column for the first time in more than five seasons. Bilunes (14.7), **Lisa Collison** (*Saginaw, Mich./Heritage*) (11.4), Wilson (10.7) and Briggs (10.1) have given SVSU its most potent offensive foursome in several years.

• BOARD OF CONTROL

The Cardinals are 3-1 when they out-rebound their opponents, while that record slips to 1-6 when their opponents get the best of the rebounding battle. In the Cardinals' four victories they have outrebounded their opponents by an average of 42.8 to 36.0 per game. In the seven losses, they have been outrebounded by an average of 42.3 to 35.9 per game.
