– PLAYER NOTES –

• SPECIAL 'K'

Freshman guard **Kara Kinzer** (*Shelby Twp., Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) had her best week as a Cardinal last week, setting career highs in seven categories. Against Northwood she recorded then career highs of 16 points and four three-pointers, while tying her career-high with four rebounds. She followed that up with a career-high 30 points, five assists, five three-pointers and twelve total field goals against Marygrove. (For a complete list of season & career highs see page 3.)

- For the week, Kinzer averaged 23.0 points per game, 3.5 rebounds per game, 3.0 assists per game and 3.0 steals per game in SVSU's two victories. She connected on an incredible 9-of-16 (.563) three-point attempts and 18-of-34 (.529) field goal attempts.

• MOVIN' ON UP

Senior guard **Jessica Wilson** (*Martin, Tenn./Westview*) knocked down two three-point field goals against Marygrove to move into a tie for fifth place in career three-pointers at SVSU. She has now made 83 career triples and is tied with Roseann Rutledge (1989-93).

- Wilson is approaching the SVSU single-season record for three-pointers. She currently has 52, while the record stands at 60. Michelle Aerts set the record during the 1994-95 season.

• FOGGIO FIRST

Sophomore forward **Sam Foggio** (*Farmington Hills, Mich./Mercy*) recorded her first career double-double (points-rebounds) in the win over Marygrove. She posted career highs of 12 points and 11 rebounds, while also knocking down a career-high five field goals against the Mustangs.

• DOUBLE TROUBLE

Sophomore **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) recorded career highs in six categories last week. Against Marygrove, she posted career highs of 24 points, nine assists, five rebounds, nine field goals and five three-pointers. Against Northwood, Bilunes set a career-high and tied an SVSU record by sinking 10-of-10 free-throw attempts.

- She averaged 20.5 points and 6.5 assists last week.

• RAINING THREES

The Cardinals are ranked sixth nationally in three-point field goals (8.1 per game). South Dakota leads the nation, averaging 9.5 triples per game.
