Hillsdale College head coach Claudette Charney coached at Saginaw Valley State for ten seasons (1985-95). Current SVSU head coach Vonnie Killmer was an assistant under Charney during the 1991-92 season. During her tenure in University Center, Charney racked up a record of 196-92 (101-63 in GLIAC play), winning two GLIAC championships along the way. Further accomplishments at SVSU include the following:

## - PLAYER NOTES -

### • JESS - I - CAN

Senior captain **Jessica Wilson** (*Martin, Tenn./Westview*) entered the season with seven career double-figure games in the scoring column and has come on strong with 19 points and 12 points in the last two games, respectively.

- Wilson added a season-high five assists in the 89-77 win over Wayne State on Thursday (Dec. 2).

### • GOIN' BACK TO KALI

Freshman **Kali Briggs** (*Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake*) had a career night against Wayne State, pouring in a career-high 22 points on 8-of-10 shooting and pulling down 17 rebounds. Briggs was on the floor for all 40 minutes in the win over the Warriors.

- Briggs has played the full 40 minutes in three of the Cardinals' six games thus far and is averaging 36.2 minutes per game.
- The 17-rebound effort against WSU allowed Briggs to stay atop the GLIAC rankings in rebounds at 12.7 per game. She also ranks first in the conference in offensive (4.33) and defensive rebounds (8.33).
- After scoring only 11 points in the first two games combined, Briggs has scored in double-figures in four consecutive games to raise her average to 12.3 points per game.

### • THREE IS A CROWD

Senior **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*), Briggs and sophomore **Lisa Collison** (*Saginaw, Mich./Heritage*) became the first trio to each crack the 20-point mark in the same game in more than five years. Bilunes and Briggs each put up a career-high 22 points, while Collison poured in a career-high 21 points in the victory.

### • FLYING HIGH WITH FIVE

Against Wayne State, the Cardinals placed five players in double figures in the scoring column for the first time since a Jan. 24, 2004 win over Grand Valley State. In addition to Bilunes, Briggs and Collison, the Cardinals had Jessica Wilson and **Stephanie Hass** (*Harbor Springs, Mich./Harbor Light Christian*) score in double figures against the Warriors. Wilson had 12 points, while Hass pitched in a season-high 10 points.

### • GIVE AND TAKE

Bilunes added a career-high eight assists to go with her game-high 22 points in the win over Wayne State.
