## – SVSU NOTABLES –

### • SENIOR SEND-OFF

Seniors **Jessica Wilson** (*Martin, Tenn./Westview*) and **Krista St. Aubin** (*Sterling Heights, Mich./Utica*) will be experiencing their final game as SVSU athletes. St. Aubin played in 48 games and started 10 games as a Cardinals. Wilson played in 58 games, starting 46, and will finish in a tie for fifth place all-time at SVSU in three-point field goals (83). Wilson's 2.74 triples per game this season is an SVSU single-season record.

### • DOUBLE-DOUBLE TROUBLE

Freshman Kali Briggs (Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake) recorded her sixth double-double (points-rebounds) of the season on Monday against Northwood. She posted 16 points and a game-high 17 rebounds. Briggs has led the Cardinals in rebounding 15 times this season.

– With her 17 boards on Monday, Briggs regained the top spot in the GLIAC in rebounding.

### • HOME SWEET HOME

Sophomore **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) has scored in double figures in all but two of the Cardinals' home games thus far. Over the course of the season, Bilunes has averaged 16.0 points per game playing in James E. O'Neill, Jr. Arena. Away from home she has averaged 14.0 points per game.

– She has also averaged 5.1 assists per home game, compared to 4.0 per game away from home.

– Bilunes came into the season with a career high of 11 points. She has now exceeded that total 18 times.

### • FEBRUARY FRENZY

Freshman **Kara Kinzer** (*Shelby Twp., Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) came into February with a season average of 5.5 points per game, a .289 field goal percentage and a .261 three-point percentage. In games played this month she has heated up, averaging 16.0 points per game and shooting an improved .371 from the field and .389 from three-point range.

### • RAINING THREES

The Cardinals are ranked 11th nationally in three-point field goals (7.5 per game). South Dakota leads the nation, averaging 9.1 triples per game.

– The Cardinals broke the SVSU single-season record on Monday as they pushed their season total to 184 three-point field goals.
