– PLAYER NOTES –

• GOIN' BACK TO KALI

Freshman forward **Kali Briggs** (*Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake*) recorded a career-high 24 points against Ferris State on Saturday (Feb. 12). She also set a career high with ten field goals and tied her career high with four steals against the Bulldogs.

- Briggs currently leads the GLIAC in rebounding and ranks 13th in all of NCAA Division II.
- She is averaging a double-double (10.2 ppg, 10.4 rpg.)

• SPECIAL 'K'

Freshman guard **Kara Kinzer** (*Shelby Twp., Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) scored 22 points against Northern Michigan on Monday (Feb. 14), giving her four double-figure games in the last five outings. She set career highs against NMU with six three-point field goals and two free throws.

- Kinzer is averaging 17.4 points in her last five games, raising her season average to 8.2.
- Kinzer is averaging 19.7 points per 40 minutes played.

• FIVE STRAIGHT

Sophomore **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) has scored in double figures in five straight games after putting up a career-high 24 points against NMU. She has now scored in double digits in 18 of the Cardinals' 22 games and is leading the team with 15.7 points per game.

- Over the last five games, Bilunes is averaging 19.0 points, 5.0 assists and 3.8 rebounds per game.
- Bilunes came into the season with a career high of 11 points. She has now exceeded that total 17 times.

• RAINING THREES

The Cardinals are ranked tenth nationally in three-point field goals (7.7 per game). South Dakota leads the nation, averaging 9.2 triples per game.

- The Cardinals have made 172 three-point field goals this season. The SVSU single-season record is 179, set in 1997-98.

• GRAND THEFT ROUND BALL

The Cardinals racked up a season-high 19 steals en route to forcing a season-high 28 turnovers against FSU on Saturday. **Krista St. Aubin** (*Sterling Heights, Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) led the way with six steals, while **Stephanie Hass** (*Harbor Springs, Mich./Harbor Light Christian*) tallied five steals and Briggs racked up four steals. All three players either set or tied a career high in steals.
