– SVSU NOTABLES –

• ROAD WARRIOR

Freshman **Kali Briggs** (*Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake*) has been solid no matter the location but has slightly better statistical averages away from University Center. She has averaged 10.7 points, 10.3 rebounds and 1.58 assists per game on the road. In home games, Briggs has posted averages of 9.4 points, 9.4 rebounds and 2.43 assists.

- Briggs has connected on 54.4% of her field goal attempts on the road, compared to 52.2% on the road.

• HOME SWEET HOME

Sophomore **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) has scored in double figures in all but two of the Cardinals' home games thus far. Over the course of the season, Bilunes has averaged 16.0 points per game playing in James E. O'Neill, Jr. Arena. Away from home she has averaged 14.4 points per game.

- She has also averaged 5.1 assists per home game, compared to 4.1 per game away from home.
- Bilunes came into the season with a career high of 11 points. She has now exceeded that total 18 times.

• FEBRUARY FRENZY

Freshman **Kara Kinzer** (*Shelby Twp., Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) came into February with a season average of 5.5 points per game, a .289 field goal percentage and a .261 three-point percentage. In games played this month she has heated up, averaging 15.3 points per game and shooting an improved .361 from the field and .375 from three-point range.

- With her torrid scoring pace this month Kinzer has raised her season average to 8.4 points per game.
- Kinzer is one of only three Cardinals with an assist/turnover ratio greater than 1.00 (1.09; 38-25).

• GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD

The Cardinals are 6-2 this season when they lead at halftime, compared to 0-16 when they are trailing at the break. They won the only game in which they were tied at halftime.
