The Cardinals swooped into Detroit and claimed a hard-fought 71-66 victory over the Warriors behind a game-high 25 points and nine rebounds from Jennifer Brogger. Valerie Smith chipped in with 17 points and game highs of 14 rebounds and five blocked shots as SVSU moved to 6-0 overall and 1-0 in the GLIAC. Wayne State was led in defeat by Jodi Young's 17 points and seven rebounds. Ebony Vincent chipped in with 14 points and a game-high seven assists, while Kristen Rogers added 12 points. Ralphanee Payton contributed eight points and a team-high 11 rebounds for the Warriors. WSU dropped to 1-4 (0-1 GLIAC).

## - PLAYER NOTES -

- Freshman forward **Kali Briggs** (*Jackson, Mich./Vandercook Lake*) has burst onto the scene with two double-doubles, three double-figure games in rebounding and three double-figure games in the scoring column. In her collegiate debut, Briggs pulled down 18 rebounds. She finished up the Florida trip with a 17-point, 13-rebound effort in the win over Nova Southeastern.

- Briggs currently leads the GLIAC with an average of 11.8 rebounds per game.

- Sophomore guard **Sara Bilunes** (*Holt, Mich.*) entered the season with a career high of 14 points but has already tied or eclipsed that mark three times in the first five games. She posted 14 points against Eckerd and then raised her career high to 18 points against Barry. Bilunes proceeded to raise the bar to 19 points in the win over Nova Southeastern. She has scored in double figures in four of the Cardinals' first five games in 2004-05.

- Bilunes also tied her career high for assists with seven against Nova Southeastern.

- Currently ranks fourth in the GLIAC in assists with an average of 4.4 per game.

- Senior guard **Jessica Wilson** (*Martin, Tenn./Westview*) closed out the Florida trip with a career-high 19 points in the win over Nova Southeastern.

- Wilson tied her career high with five rebounds against Puerto Rico Bayamon.

- Sophomore **Lisa Collison** (*Saginaw, Mich./Heritage*) scored a career-high 19 points in the win over Warner Southern. Her previous career high of 16 points came against Gannon last season. Collison also dished out a career-high five assists against Barry.

- Freshman **Kara Kinzer** (*Shelby Twp., Mich./Utica Eisenhower*) recorded her first career double-figure scoring game with 14 points in the win over Warner Southern. Kinzer knocked down 4-of-8 three-point attempts and 5-of-11 field goal attempts overall.

- Sophomore **Sam Foggio** (*Farmington Hills, Mich./Mercy*) pulled down a career-high ten boards against Puerto Rico Bayamon. Her previous career high was seven rebounds against Rochester College last season.
