



FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

The Fine Arts Scholarship is available to incoming freshmen who have earned a 3.0 or better grade point average and plan to major in art, art education or graphic design. The scholarship covers tuition and fees per academic year and is renewable for three years as long as you maintain a 3.0 grade point average as a full-time student at SVSU and continue to major in art, art education or graphic design.

If you wish to apply for the scholarship, you should:

1. Complete scholarship application.
2. Submit two letters of recommendation from the following persons: teacher, clergy, principal, counselor, or employer. One letter of recommendation must come from an art teacher specifically evaluating your potential as a student in fine arts. Recommendation forms are attached.
3. Attach a typewritten narrative (200-300 words) describing your particular interest in the arts and how you plan to pursue that interest in your career goals.
