## Admission Guidelines

Applications for students enrolling out of high school are considered individually. Admission to SVSU is based on academic preparation and demonstrated ability.

- Students with a 3.0 or higher grade point average (approximately 70% average) will be admitted.
- Those below the above listed percentage may be admitted based on counselor recommendations and extra-curricular involvement indicating potential to succeed in college.

## Applicants

1. Fill out application completely.
2. A non-refundable application fee of \$25 U.S. Dollars (check or money order payable to SVSU) must accompany your application. To pay by credit card, complete the area on Page 3.
3. If you are a high school student, submit completed application to your guidance office. Ask that it be forwarded with an official copy of your high school record to SVSU's Office of Admissions.
4. If you are a student planning to transfer to SVSU, you must arrange to have official transcripts from each college or university previously attended sent directly to the SVSU Office of Admissions.
5. The Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT) is required if a student plans to participate in varsity athletics or to qualify for additional academic scholarships other than the Horizon Scholarship.

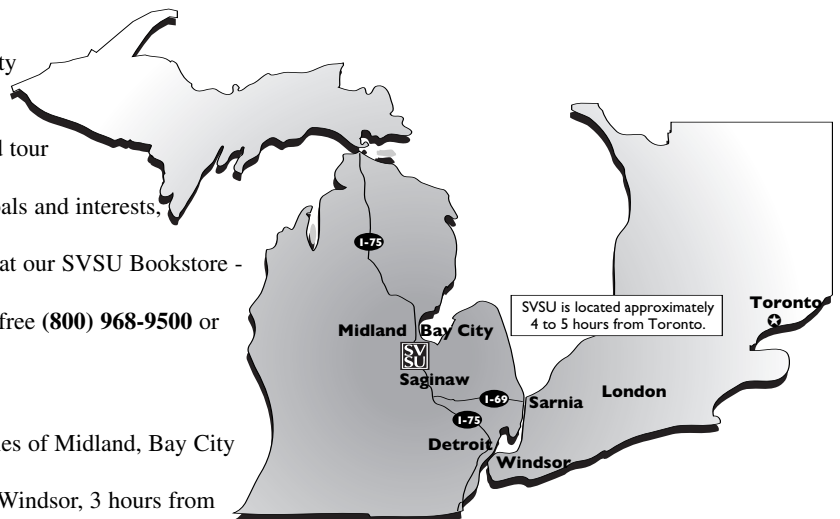

SVSU is an approved university for Ontario students. An application can be obtained from your high school guidance department or on-line at <http://osap.gov.on.ca>. Maximum OSAP eligibility for SVSU is currently \$7,425 (CD) per year (i.e., approximately one full semester of tuition/ fees and housing).

**Horizon Scholarship:** An academic scholarship worth up to \$8,095 Canadian annually. Students automatically qualify if their GPA percentage is 75% or higher.

- Canadian students are eligible to compete for athletic scholarships in any of our varsity sports. The scholarship amount varies by the sport as well as athletic ability. Contact the appropriate coach.

### Employment

You should not plan to finance your education in the U.S. through part- or full-time employment. U.S. Regulations do not allow citizens of other countries to accept off-campus employment unless they have received specific authorization from the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services. International students are eligible for up to 20 hours of on-campus employment during the fall and winter semesters or 40 hours of on-campus employment during the summer and may compete with other students for those positions.
