Three (3) credits from:

ENGL 272 American Literature (3)
ENGL 299 Selected Topics in Literature (American only) 1-4

Three (3) credits from: (ENGL 355 or ENGL 370 highly recommended)

- ENGL 345 History of the English Language (3)
ENGL 350 Dialects in Contemporary English (3)
ENGL 355 Language in Society (3)
ENGL 370 Language in Education (3)

Three (3) credits from:

- ENGL 261 Introduction to Creative Writing (3)
ENGL 305 Creative Writing: Poetry (3)
ENGL 306 Creative Writing: Fiction (3)

Three (3) credits from any Literature course excluding those listed above.

If English is part of your Planned Program, take English 300 (or English 301 [prerequisite English 201]), and English 380 [prerequisite English 300 or 301 and Admission to the Teacher Education Program]; and six credits from the following: English 201; 261; 271 or 272; 305, 306, 345, 350, 355, or 370; or 3 credits from any Literature course.

MTTC Subject-Area Test: Students who choose to Minor in English and wish to become certified to teach English in grades 6-8 (optional, although recommended), should plan to take the MTTC “English” subject-area test prior to or during student teaching.
