

Earl Warrick Award for Excellence in Research

Selection Criteria

The Earl Warrick Award is given annually to an SVSU faculty member who has made a significant and/or longstanding contribution to the advancement of knowledge in a recognized field of scholarship or artistic endeavor. Letters of nomination should cite evidence of excellence in research such as the following:

- Publications of original research in refereed scholarly journals
- Exhibitions and/or performances in juried venues
- Presentations of original research at juried conferences
- External funding awards for scholarly activities
- External awards for research and publication
- Positive reviews of work in refereed journals
- Citations of work in other works
