



STUDENT-HOST INSTRUCTION FORM (NCAA BYLAW 13.6.5.5)

Your role as a **Student-Athlete Host** is very important in the recruiting process for your team. By agreeing to be a host, you take on a responsibility to understand and abide by NCAA and SVSU rules. You will display conduct of the highest ethics and integrity while representing your team and your school. Any violation of university policy or laws of the state of Michigan will not be tolerated. Carefully review the following rules as you will be held personally responsible for following them:

1. Do not place the recruit or yourself in a compromising situation. You are to sell your team, institution, and community in a positive manner. Therefore, do not place the recruit or yourself in an environment that can be construed as illegal or unethical.
2. Only one SVSU student-athlete per day can serve as an official host. Other students may assist with hosting the prospect, but must pay for their own entertainment and meals. Only one student host per prospect may be provided with a free meal if restaurant facilities are used.
3. A maximum of \$30 for each day of the visit may be provided to cover all actual cost of entertaining the prospect, the prospect’s parents, legal guardians or spouse, and yourself, excluding the cost of meals and admission to campus events. These funds may not be used for purchasing souvenirs such as t-shirts or other institutional mementos. It is permissible to provide the student host with an additional \$15 per day for each additional prospect the host entertains.
4. No cash may be given to the visiting prospect or anyone else.
5. You may not use automobiles provided or arranged for by any coach, athletics department staff member, or booster of SVSU. Never allow the prospect to use or drive your car.
6. You may not take the recruit (or their family) more than 30 miles from the campus.
7. You cannot allow recruiting conversations to occur off-campus between the prospect and a booster. (If an unplanned meeting occurs, only an exchange of greetings is permissible.)
8. You may receive a complimentary admission to a home athletics event when accompanying a prospect.
9. After the visit, you must turn in to your coach receipts to account for all money expended while hosting the recruit.
