This application is to be used for admission to SVSU for the post-baccalaureate initial teacher certification, endorsement, master's, specialist's and non-degree teaching certificate programs.

Guest students must submit the *Michigan Intercollegiate Guest Application*, which can be obtained from their home institution, or by contacting the SVSU College of Education Office of Admissions & Certification.

International students seeking admission must complete the *International Student Application for Graduate Admission* found at www.svsu.edu/gradadm.

CHECKLIST TO COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

Before you begin, please read and follow these instructions!

1. Be sure to complete all sections and sign the application form.
2. Include your check, money order, or provide credit card information for the \$25 non-refundable application fee. Make your check or money order payable to *Saginaw Valley State University*.
3. Submit official transcripts from each college or university where credit was earned. The SVSU Office of Admissions and Certification must receive the transcripts in a sealed envelope issued by the college or university. To expedite the processing of this application, these sealed transcripts should be submitted with the application. Applicants who have completed credit at SVSU are not required to submit a copy of their SVSU transcript.
4. Attach a copy of your teaching certificate (if applicable).

Please note: Applicants who have recently completed a teacher preparation program at another institution must attach a letter to the application from their home institution confirming they have successfully completed all coursework and state testing requirements and are eligible to be recommended for certification.

5. Applicants who have not earned a teaching certificate and are seeking admission to a graduate program requiring teaching credentials must receive approval from the appropriate department chair or faculty advisor before admission can be granted. When completing the personal statement within the application, applicants must explain why they are seeking admission and how this academic program will apply to their professional goals. **Please note: Completion of a graduate program does not lead to a Michigan teaching certificate.**
6. Submit a statement of personal goals.
7. Provide three letters of recommendation (Education Specialist applicants only).
8. Submit a current resume/vita (Education Specialist applicants only)

ADMISSION POLICIES & PROCEDURES

This application is valid for the semester selected on the enclosed application. Applicants, who do not register for courses within the indicated semester, must contact the College of Education Office of Admissions & Certification to request a change in the start term. The application will be valid for one year. After one year, a new application and supporting documents may be required.

All credits and requirements toward a master's or specialist degree, including transfer credits, must be completed within seven years. Transfer credits are valid for seven years from the time the course was taken, not from the time of transfer.

READMISSION POLICY

Any student who has not been enrolled for seven (7) consecutive semesters must apply for re-admission. A re-admitted student is subject to all regulations and requirements for the current catalog at the time of his/her re-admission. Official transcripts from any college or university attended following SVSU must be submitted with the application for re-admission.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The College of Education reserves the right to revise or amend their admission requirements beyond the minimum requirement set by the University.

TRANSFER CREDIT

A maximum of nine (9) transfer credits from a regionally-accredited college or university may be applied to a graduate degree program. A grade of "B" or higher must have been earned in each transfer course. Transfer credits are only valid for seven (7) years from the time the course was taken, not from the time of transfer.
