

SVSU Music Scholarships

The **Distinctive Program in Music Scholarships** are awarded to students who, due to their exceptional music performing ability and outstanding course work in music or music education, will bring distinction to the department. Students selected to receive this award will also become part of the Music Ambassadors to the Schools program. The scholarship is awarded for one academic year, and is renewable based on the recommendation of the faculty.

The **Rhea Miller Scholarships in Music** are awarded based on an audition, interview, and musicianship tests. The scholarship amount of \$2,000 is awarded for one academic year. It may be renewed upon the recommendation of the faculty.

The **Patsy Hill Schwartz Scholarship** is given to a student who has shown leadership in the Department of Music or has demonstrated high academic achievement in music.

The **Marching Band and Pep Band Scholarships** are available to all SVSU students and have an approximate value of \$350. A limited number of **Pep Band Scholarships** are available with a value of \$200.

The **Barbara Mitchell Voice Scholarship** is open to music and music education students with a GPA of 2.5 or above.

The **James and Rosemary Hill Scholarship** is open to music and music education students. The scholarship is awarded for one academic year and is based on financial need. The student must have an overall GPA of 2.75 with 3.0 GPA in music courses.
