ALL APPLICANTS - ADMISSION CRITERIA

Each application is considered individually. Admission to SVSU is based on academic preparation and demonstrated ability. Admissible students' academic credentials will fit one of the following:

- High School (Secondary School) graduates with 70% or higher cumulative grade point average (grades 9-12).
- Transfer, Second Bachelor's Degree, and Re-Admission students with a 2.00 or higher cumulative grade point average on a 4.00 scale from all post-secondary institutions attended.

ALL APPLICANTS - SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

HORIZON SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATES

Awarded upon admission to qualifying Canadian students for their undergraduate coursework, the Horizon Scholarship can save recipients over 50% on their SVSU tuition. Eligible candidates are those admitted SVSU undergraduate degree-seeking applicants who meet the above-stated admission criteria. The Horizon Scholarship is a non-competitive, renewable award for students who maintain eligibility standards.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS AND/OR VARSITY ATHLETE APPLICANTS

The Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT) is required for the following:

- if a high school applicant plans to participate in SVSU varsity athletics, and
- for all applicants who wish to be considered for academic scholarships beyond the Horizon Scholarship.

ALL APPLICANTS - STUDENT TYPES & RELATED INSTRUCTIONS

FIRST TIME IN ANY COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY: Any student who has not enrolled in a post-secondary institution after the summer following high school graduation.

High School (Secondary School) Graduates/Students

1. Application for admission may be submitted as soon as possible after completion of Grade 11 once corresponding marks are posted to your transcript.
2. Arrange with your high school guidance office to have your official high school transcript forwarded directly to SVSU's Office of Admissions, ATTN: Canadian Liaison.

TRANSFER: Any student who has enrolled in another post-secondary institution after the summer following high school graduation, before attending SVSU.

1. Arrange with the records/registration office (at each of your post-secondary institutions attended) to have your official college/university transcript from that institution forwarded directly to SVSU's Office of Admissions, ATTN: Canadian Liaison.
2. If you have not completed a post-secondary diploma or degree, then you need to supply at least an unofficial copy of your secondary school (high school) transcript and/or diploma.
3. If you have completed fewer than 24 academic credits, then you need to supply a copy of your secondary (high school) transcript.

SECOND BACHELOR'S DEGREE:

If you already have a bachelor's degree, arrange with the records/registration office (at each of your post-secondary institutions attended) to have your official college/university transcript from that institution forwarded directly to SVSU's Office of Admissions, ATTN: Canadian Liaison.

RE-ADMISSION

If you have previously attended SVSU but have completed courses at any other institution(s) since last attending SVSU, arrange to have your official transcript(s) sent directly to the SVSU Registrar's Office.

ALL APPLICANTS - APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Apply up to one full year prior to your anticipated start date - the earlier, the better.
- Complete your application accurately. FOR BEST AND FASTEST RESULTS, PRINT NEATLY IN BLUE OR BLACK INK AND IN ALL CAPITAL LETTERS. Review your work before submitting.
- A one-time, non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 U.S. (made with either a check or money order drawn from a U.S. funds account) must accompany your application. Make payable to Saginaw Valley State University. Include the applicant's name on the check. Do **not** send checks or money orders drawn from non-U.S. funds accounts. (No credit card payment option with the paper application.)
- Proof of Citizenship. Submit a photocopy of your valid, signed picture passport (and government-issued birth record, if available) to suffice as provisional evidence of your citizenship until your official, original documents can be presented in person to your Canadian Liaison and the SVSU Office of International Programs for review.
- Evidence of Financial Support. See Page 4 of this application for details.
- After your credentials are received, you will be notified regarding admission. (Allow 7-14 business days' mailing time for cross-border postal service, plus additional processing time and return mailing time.)
- Upon review of all final documents, if all criteria for admission to Saginaw Valley State University are not met, the University reserves the right to withhold and/or rescind admission.

SAGINAW VALLEY STATE UNIVERSITY IS AUTHORIZED UNDER U.S. FEDERAL LAW TO ENROLL NON-IMMIGRANT ALIEN STUDENTS.
