With acceptable ACT or SAT scores (ACT preferred), students with a minimum six- or seven-semester high school grade point average of 2.50 or higher in college prep courses are admissible. Those with a minimum seven-semester grade point average of 2.00 or higher may be admitted if test scores and extracurricular involvement indicate they would be likely to succeed in college.

Students who wish to transfer should have maintained a minimum 2.00 grade point average in all college courses taken. Your application and official copies of your transcript(s) should be sent directly to the Office of Admissions, Saginaw Valley State University, 7400 Bay Road, University Center, MI 48710.

First Time In Any College

1. High School Students
 - A. Application for admission may be submitted after completion of your junior year.
 - B. Submit your completed application to the proper high school official who will forward the application and transcript of your high school record to the Office of Admissions.
 - C. An ACT or SAT score is required of high school seniors.
2. High School Graduates
 - A. All high school graduates are requested to have official high school transcripts, or GED if applicable, and ACT or SAT scores sent to the Office of Admissions.
 - B. An application for admission may be made any time after graduation from high school, or successful completion of the GED. Students who have graduated from high school with a minimum grade point average of 2.00 and a minimum score on the ACT (17) or SAT (810) will be admitted. Students age 22 and over who have a high school diploma or GED, but have not completed the ACT or SAT, will be contacted by the Office of Admissions regarding any additional assessment that may be required to determine their ability and potential to succeed in college.
3. Dual Enrollment – High School Students
 - A. Complete an application for admission.
 - B. Submit a copy of your high school transcripts.
 - C. Submit a completed SVSU Dual Enrollment form if school district will be responsible for payment. (Dual enrollment forms may be obtained from the SVSU Office of Admissions or online at www.svsu.edu/undergradadm/.)
 - D. No application fee is required.

Transfer

1. Arrange to have an official transcript from every college or university attended sent directly to the Office of Admissions.
2. Applicants will be notified if test scores are needed.
3. If you have not completed an Associate's Degree, a copy of your high school transcripts, diploma, or GED is required.

Re-Admission

If you have completed courses at any other institution since last attending SVSU, arrange to have an official transcript of your record sent directly to the Registrar's Office.

Second Bachelor's Degree

Arrange to have an official transcript from each college or university attended sent directly to the Office of Admissions.

Non-Degree

1. Post baccalaureate students: college transcripts are not required.

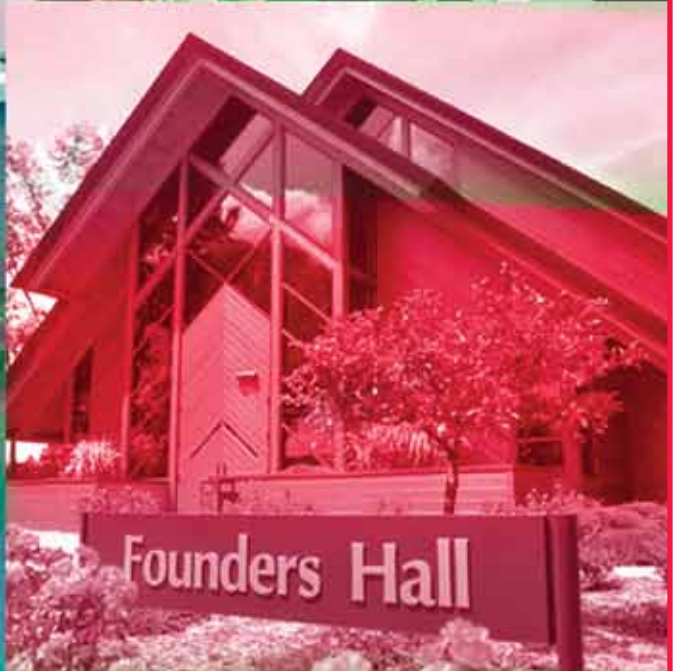
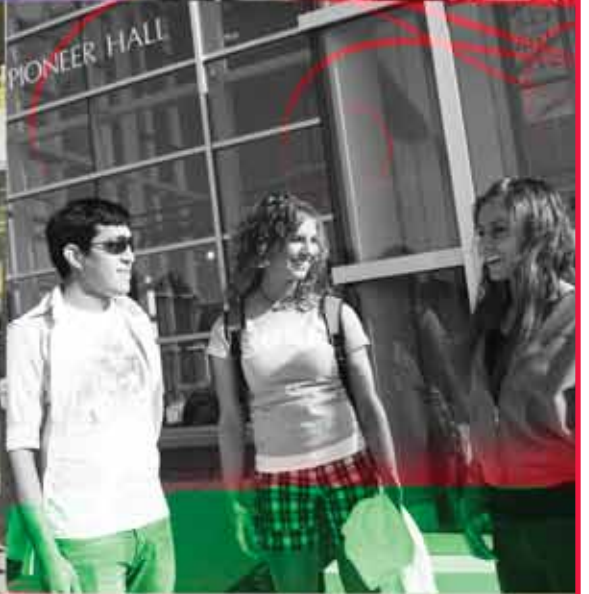
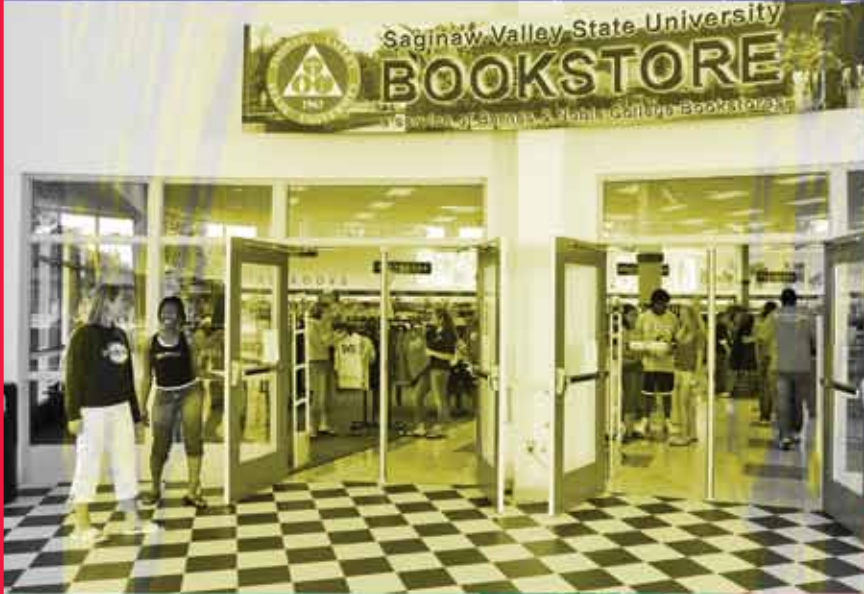
