This is a nasal mist flu vaccine and may be administered only to healthy individuals age 24 or younger. Some individuals are not eligible to receive the nasal flu mist vaccine for health-related reasons. See list of possible contraindications below.

Some Health-Related Contraindications to the Nasal Mist Flu Vaccine:

- Cannot be pregnant.
- Cannot have received another nasal vaccine (for regular flu) within 28 days.
- Should not have asthma or other chronic pulmonary conditions.
- Should not have current cardiovascular issues, excluding high blood pressure.
- Should not have renal, hepatic, cognitive, neurologic/neuromuscular conditions, hematologic or metabolic disorders, such as diabetes or immunosuppression.
- Should not have allergy to eggs or reaction to previous vaccine or vaccine components.

If you are moderately or severely ill, you might be advised to wait until you recover before getting the vaccine.
