Welcome back to campus for the 2011-2012 academic year. As you return, we want you to be aware of a few changes to campus drives and parking lots that have been made over the summer.

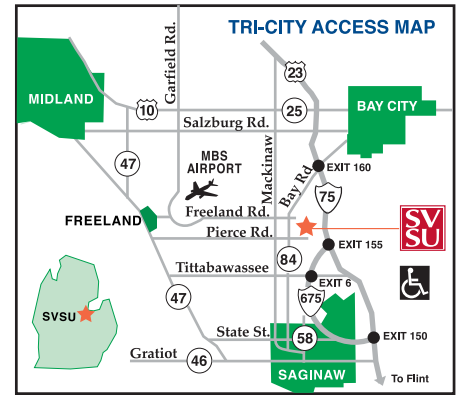
Due to the high level of vehicle and pedestrian activity on campus we advise everyone to become knowledgeable of the campus roadway system and location of parking lots. Students in particular should plan appropriately to allow sufficient time prior to class to locate a parking space.

An updated SVSU campus map can also be accessed at www.svsu.edu/universitypolice/parking-information along with other pertinent parking and driving information. A few minor changes for the 2011/2012 academic year are as follows:

- University Drive between the J-Lots and Curtiss Hall is no longer a throughway. J-1 and J-2 Lots have a connected drive, located near the end of the lots, to allow for access through both. **If your ultimate destination is lots J-2, J-3, or J-4, use Collings Drive to enter these lots from the south.**
- The entire R-Lot is now available with the completion of the recreation facility addition.
- J-4 Lot is open with the completion of the Curtiss Hall and Student Center renovations. J-4 Lot has spaces for faculty/staff parking and resident students.
- Parking meters have been moved from F-Lot and placed in D-Lot for better utilization.
- Additional parking meters have been placed in J-1 Lot and J-2 Lot.
- As a reminder, C-Lot (east of Davis Road) is open parking.
