General Guidelines – CMS Bibliography Page:

- The bibliography appears at the end of the paper. Include all works cited and consulted other than personal communications. (See CMS 14.218-9, 14.222-3 for personal communication.)
- Use 12-pt. Times New Roman font.

Format for Bibliography:

- Center “Bibliography,” and double space below. Single space entries with double spaces between entries.
- Alphabetize by authors’ last name; if author has two publications, list by date order, and replace the author’s name in the second entry with the 3-em dash (see CMS 14.63-5).
- Type the first line of each entry flush left and indent additional lines five spaces.
