II. ACTION ITEM

1. Consideration of setting a Surcharge on Student Tuition Rates

President Ryder, with a few brief comments about the latest proposed cuts by Governor Milliken, recommended that the Executive Committee, as authorized by the Board of Control at its Regular Meeting on November 10. 1980, adopt a resolution levying a surcharge on tuition for the ensuing winter, spring and summer terms.

	WHEREAS, The 1980-81 state appropriation has not yet
	been finalized, and
	WHEREAS, The current recommendation for 1980-81 is
	several hundred thousand dollars less than the 1979-80
	state appropriation, and
	WHEREAS, The demand for educational services continues
	to increase as is evidenced by over a 12% increase in
	student headcount and over a 15% increase in student
	credit hours for the fall 1980 semester, and
	WHEREAS, Costs tied to inflation continue to adversely
	affect the programs of the institution;
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That a tuition surcharge
	of \$2.50 per credit hour for only the winter 1980-81
	semester and spring term 1980-81 and summer term of
	1981-82 be implemented.

Motion unanimously carried to adopt RES-486 regarding a tuition surcharge.
