## CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES



### MARY STALLINGS COLEMAN

Doctor of Laws

Mary Stallings Coleman is chief justice of the Michigan Supreme Court. She has played a vital role in the field of law and community service in the state of Michigan.

Elected chief justice January 9, 1979, she is a member of the bar in both the District of Columbia and Michigan, and was formerly probate and juvenile judge of Calhoun County, Battle Creek, from 1961-1973. She holds a Juris Doctor degree from George Washington University, and received her Bachelor's degree from the University of Maryland.

Coleman is married to Creighton R. Coleman, circuit judge and formerly state senator and majority leader, as well as her former law partner. They have two daughters. She has been awarded Woman of the Year honors twice, from Soroptomist and the Michigan Association of the Professions in 1976. She has received the Michigan State University Distinguished Citizen Award in 1977, and DAR Medal of Honor in 1978 among many others.



### G. JAMES WILLIAMS

Doctor of Laws

G. James Williams, financial vice president and member of the Board of Directors for The Dow Chemical Company, has been an avid supporter of Saginaw Valley State College since its inception. As Chairman of the Board of Directors for the SVSC Foundation, he is an active fund-raiser.

Williams joined Dow in 1948 after receiving his Bachelor's degree from Williams College in 1942. He graduated from the University of Michigan Law School in 1948 with a Juris Doctor degree.

He has served Dow in many capacities, as a member of the Legal Department, assistant sales manager in the Plastics Department, sales manager in Plastics, assistant general sales manager, general sales manager, director of marketing, general manager of Plastics, and commerce director and executive vice president of Dow U.S.A.

He was elected to Dow's Board of Directors in August 1968, and was named to his present position as financial vice president in 1975. He is a member of the Board's executive committee and finance committee.

In addition to his duties at Dow, he is a board member of Dow Corning Corporation, Chemical Bank and Trust Company of Midland, chairman of the board of directors of the National Legal Center for the Public Interest, and a member of the board of directors of the National Association of Manufacturers.

He and his wife, Lyla, have two daughters and a son and live in Midland.

## THE 1979 FRANC A. LANDEE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

### DONALD F. NOVEY

Associate Professor of Economics

Donald F. Novey began his career at Saginaw Valley State College as an instructor in economics in 1969. Earlier he had been an assistant professor, associate professor, and chairman of the economics department at West Virginia State College, Charleston.

He earned degrees from South Dakota State University in 1955 and 1959 and has conducted extensive research in the area of extending the Great Lakes navigation season.

Novey has been active in the SVSC Faculty Association, of which he is now president, as well as many other organizations. He is a member of the Michigan Economics Associations, in addition to Pi Gamma Mu, national honorary for social science. He has served six years as treasurer for the Association of Michigan Collegiate Faculties as well. His wife, Dr. Rose Novey, is also on the SVSC faculty and teaches in the mathematics department.



### HARRIET E. TILLOCK

Assistant Professor of Sociology  
Chairwoman, Department of Sociology

Harriet E. Tillock started at Saginaw Valley State College on a part-time basis as a sociology instructor in 1972. She has been a full-time faculty member since 1974 and department chairwoman since 1976. She studied social science and sociology at Michigan State University, where she received her Ph.D. degree in 1976.

Her teaching experience includes work as an elementary instructor from 1962-1967, and a teaching assistant and instructor at MSU from 1968-1971. Tillock currently serves on SVSC's Academic Policies Committee, Residential Life Scholarship Committee, and the Saginaw County Steering Committee for the Year of the Child. She is a member of the American, Rural, and North Central Sociological Associations, World Population Society, Society for the Study of Social Problems, and is faculty coordinator for SVSC's Committee for the Handicapped.

She and her husband, Dr. Robert A. Tillock, have one daughter and three grandchildren.

## GRADUATION ATTIRE

Following a code adopted by the Intercollegiate Commission in New York City in 1895 and used by more American Colleges and universities, our graduates today are wearing gowns made of black material. Sleeves on the gowns of bachelor's degree recipients are long and pointed, while master's degree gowns have long sleeves which are closed at the bottom.

Hoods, made of the same acetate material as the gown, are lined in cardinal red with the second school color — blue — indicated by the chevron. In addition, the colored velvet or velveteen edging on the hood designates the department or faculty from which the degree was issued.

## THE INSIGNIA OF SAGINAW VALLEY STATE COLLEGE

The geographical area formed by Bay City, Midland and Saginaw, popularly known as "The Golden Triangle," is represented by the triangle within the Saginaw Valley State College seal. This depicts the merging of three separate urban communities, with a combined population of more than 400,000, into the metropolitan Saginaw Valley.

The three symbols within the seal are of Egyptian origin. The figure at the top stands for live or living, denoting the fact that education is an ongoing, life long process and has a value which lasts forever.

The symbol at the lower left represents light — perhaps the inner light. It recognizes that "our knowledge is a torch of smoky pine that lights the pathway but one step ahead." Standing opposite this light of knowledge in the lower right corner is a staff, which stands for strength. This may be regarded as an appeal for the endurance necessary to search for and find the truth, and the strength to speak and live it.
