CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES



JAMES H. BRICKLEY
DOCTOR OF LAWS

James H. Brickley, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Michigan, was born in Flint and raised in Detroit. He received his bachelor of philosophy and law degrees from the University of Detroit and earned a master's degree in public and administrative law from New York University.

His career in public service has extended through all levels of government - municipal, county, state and federal. He has served as a Special Agent with the F.B.I., on the Detroit Common Council, as Chief Assistant Prosecutor for Wayne County, and as U.S. Attorney for Eastern Michigan.

He was first elected Lieutenant Governor with Governor William G. Milliken in 1970. From 1975 to 1978 he served as President of Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. In 1978, he was again elected Lieutenant Governor with Governor Milliken.



MARSHALL M. FREDERICKS
DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS

An internationally acclaimed sculptor, Marshall M. Fredericks is a graduate of the Cleveland School of Art. He has studied in Sweden, Germany, France and Italy, traveling extensively in Europe and North Africa.

He has received Gold Medal Awards from the American Institute of Architects, the Architectural League of New York, and the Michigan Academy of Science, Arts and Letters. Among his other awards are the Henry Hering Medal from the National Sculpture Society and the 1966 Distinguished Service Award from the American Academy of Achievement.

Fredericks is an Academician of the National Academy of Design, a Fellow of the National Sculptural Society and the International Institute of Arts and Letters; a member of the

Michigan Society of Architects, the American Institute of Decorators, and the National Society of Interior Designers. He is also the recipient of numerous foreign titles and decorations and is the Royal Danish Consul for Michigan.

His works can be seen in such places as the State Department Building in Washington D.C.; several locations in Detroit, the Dallas City Library; Churchill Square in Freeport, Grand Bahamas Island, and the Midland Center for the Arts.



IRENE WARSAW
DOCTOR OF LETTERS

Irene Warsaw, a native and resident of Bay City, has published hundreds of poems in such national magazines as Saturday Evening Post, Good Housekeeping, McCall's, New York Times Magazine, Sports Illustrated, Reader's Digest and Wall Street Journal. She has two volumes of poetry in print at the present time, "A Word in Edgewise" (1964); and "Warily We Roll Along" (1979), for which she received the Orville Crowder Miller Award from the National League of American Pen Women.

She is a member of the National League of American Pen Women, Detroit Women Writers, the Poetry Society of Michigan, Pennsylvania Poetry Society, Poet's Study Club of Terre Haute, and the American Academy of Poets.

Highly respected in her field, Warsaw has acted as judge for many poetry contests. She has lectured at schools, colleges and writers' conferences, and is frequently guest speaker for clubs and other organizations.

Ms. Warsaw is a retired Vice President and Trust Officer from Peoples National Bank and Trust Company, where her career focused on the areas of trusts and estates.

THE 1980 FRANC A. LANDEE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

GEORGE W. EASTLAND
CHAIRMAN, DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

Dr. George W. Eastland joined the SVSC faculty as assistant professor of chemistry in 1969. He earned a bachelor of science from Wittenberg University and his Ph.D. degree in chemistry from South Dakota State University.

Eastland is a member of the Royal Institute of Chemistry, London, England; the American Chemical Society; and the New York Academy of Sciences. He is listed in "American Men and Women of Science" and "Who's Who in Education". He has conducted extensive research in the field of chemotherapy and published numerous scientific papers.

In addition to teaching and research, Eastland has served as SVSC faculty athletic representative to the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and played an active role in planning expanded science facilities at SVSC.

He and his wife Judith have two daughters.

Delight Bladecki McGrandy, a 1974 B.A. graduate from SVSC, is chairman of the nursing division at Delta College. She received her master's degree from Wayne State University in 1977 and has taken post-graduate work at Marquette University.

Her extensive community activity includes serving on the board of directors of the East Central Michigan Health Services Agency, advisory committees for the nursing programs at Delta and SVSC, and the advisory committee for Wayne State's graduate nursing outreach program.

Professional affiliations include the American and Michigan Nurses Associations, Bay District Nurses, and American Association of University Professors. She is also a member of the National League of Nursing (NLN) and is state co-chairman of its liaison committee with the American Association of Community and Junior Colleges. She has assisted the group with competency development and has served on several task forces.

Following a code adopted by the Intercollegiate Commission in New York City in 1895 and used by more American colleges and universities, our graduates today are wearing gowns made of black material. Sleeves on the gowns of bachelor's degree recipients are long and pointed, while master's degree gowns have long sleeves which are closed at the bottom.

Hoods, made of the same acetate material as the gown, are lined in cardinal red with the second school color — blue — indicated by the chevron. In addition, the colored velvet or velveteen edging on the hood designates the department or faculty from which the degree was issued.
