## **CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES**



#### RUTH E. BRIDGE DOCTOR OF HUMANITIES

Ruth E. Bridge currently is president of the SVSC Triskelions, an organization of area women who have raised nearly \$200,000 for scholarships to SVSC students with superior academic accomplishments. She previously has served on the Triskelions' board of directors and has been program chairmand and consignment shop board secretary.

Mother of six, she is and has been very active in various community services. Memberships have included the PTA, Girl Scout and Campfire groups, Midland Women's Study Club, and P.E.O. Sisterhood, a women's philanthropic educational organization. She also is active in the Women's Auxiliary to the Midland County Medical Society and has been its president and secretary. In addition, she is a board member of the Midland County Tuberculosis Association, and a volunteer assisting the Council on Domestic Violence.

Both Mrs. Bridge and her husband, Robert, are members of the Memorial Presbyterian Church, Midland. She was awarded an honorary membership in the Program Agency of the Presbyterian Church, U.S.A. by the Women's Association in 1979. At present, she serves on the Board of Deacons and the church Library Board.

After graduating in 1949 from Northwestern Hospital School of Nursing in Minneapolis, she worked as a Registered Nurse at Rochester General Hospital in New York while her husband completed his residency there.

Her special interests center around home, family and grandchildren.



## PAUL F. OREFFICE DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

Paul F. Oreffice has been president and chief executive officer of The Dow Chemical Company and chairman of its Executive Committee since May, 1978.

After joining Dow in 1953, his career steps included becoming an area sales manager in Milan, Italy; organizer and manager of Dow Quimica do Brazil, a Dow subsidiary company; commercial director of Dow Unquinesa, Bilbao, Spain; and general manager for Dow International of Spain in 1963. He received the Encomienda del Merito Civil (Order of Civil Merit) from the government of Spain in 1966 for his distinguished service. That same year he was appointed president and general manager of Dow Chemical Latin America.

In 1970 he returned to Midland as financial vice president of the company, and he was elected to Dow's Board of Direc-

tors in 1971 and appointed to the executive committee the following year. He was Dow Chemical U.S.A. President from 1975 until being named to his present position.

Currently Mr. Oreffice is chairman of the board of the Chemical Manufacturers Association, a director of First Bank Corporation of Midland, Dow Corning Corporation, and Connecticut General Insurance Company. He also serves on the board of trustees of American Enterprise Institute, the policy committee of the Business Roundtable, the board of trustees of the Midland Community Center, and the national board of directors of Junior Achievement.

Born in Venice, Italy, Mr. Oreffice come to the U.S. with his family at age 12, becoming an American citizen and later serving in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict. He is a 1949 graduate of Purdue University with a bachelor of science degree in chemical engineering and received an honorary Doctor of Engineering degree there in 1976. He and his wife, Franca, have two children.



## WALTER ERNEST WALPOLE DOCTOR OF LAWS

Walter E. Walpole was born in Chicago and attended Principia College in St. Louis, Missouri. He began his business career in a Chicago bank as an office boy and then rose to a position of analyst in the credit department. Six years later, he joined Borg and Beck Company of Chicago — one of the nucleus of four companies that formed the Borg-Warner Corporation. As Secretary-Treasurer, he left the Marvel-Schebler Carburetor Division of Borg-Warner after 24 years with the organization. In 1950, he formed the Walbro Corporation of Fenton, Michigan.

The organization has grown since then. The original corporation was moved to Cass City. Additions since then have included a fuel pump plant in Caro, Michigan, an injection molded plastics parts plant in Bad Axe, Michigan, a die castings plant of aluminum and magnesium materials

in Auburn, Michigan, and several off-shore subsidiaries in Nogales, U.S. and Mexico, Kawasaki City, Japan, Singapore, and Stuttgart, Germany.

Mr. Walpole was president of Walbro Corporation until 1977 when he became chairman of the board and chief executive officer.

He is currently an active business leader, travels extensively, and is a member of the Bay City Country Club.



## EARL L. WARRICK DOCTOR OF HUMANITIES

Earl L. Warrick, retired Dow Corning Corporation senior management consultant, served as interim dean for the School of Science and Engineering and Technology at SVSC in 1979-80.

A doctoral graduate of Carnegie Institute of Technology, his basic research in silicones made possible the birth and growth of the silicone industry and led to the decision to establish Dow Corning Corporation. He is the holder, or correcipient, of 44 U.S. patents and has published widely in the fields of polymer chemistry and numerous areas of silicone research, including silicone rubber and other silicone elastomers. He received the prestigious Goodyear Medal in 1976.

Sharing his experience and expertise, Dr. Warrick taught at Carnegie Institute, Brown University and the University

of Pittsburgh. In the area of basic research, he was appointed fellow, senior fellow and administrative fellow at the Mellon Institute.

An active community leader, Dr. Warrick currently is president of the Midland Center for the Arts and serves on the Midland County Library Board, the United Fund, and the Midland Art Council. He was governor of Rotary district 631 last year and is a Paul Harris Fellow. Internationally he has traveled extensively to Germany for a silicone research extension program, to France for an administrative assignment, and to Japan for a cooperative project in silicone technology.

Dr. Warrick and his wife, Jean, are Midland residents.

# THE 1981-82 FRANC A. LANDEE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING



## JOHN V. JEZIERSKI PROFESSOR OF HISTORY

Dr. John V. Jezierski is SVSC's 1981-82 recipient of the Landee award for excellence in teaching. A professor of history, he has taught at SVSC since 1970 and chaired the important College Goals and Objectives committee. He also is active in numerous historical societies and civic groups.

Although a native of Cleveland, Ohio who graduated from John Carroll University and earned his Ph.D. degree from the University of Indiana, Jezierski has become a leading authority on history of the Saginaw Valley region. His recent research and publications have dealt with Saginaw Valley demography from 1850-1900, the Goodridge brothers: pioneer Saginaw photographers, and the image of the black man in a lumber boom town.

Publications have included articles in the Journal of the History of Ideas, New England Quarterly, New York History, Journal of American History, North Dakota Quarterly, The Michigan Academician, Pennsylvania Histroy, The American Examiner, Indiana Magazine of History, Michigan History and SVSC's Economic and Business Review.

To increase awareness of our rich historical and cultural heritage, Jezierski has prepared lectures and slide presentations for television programs, area civic and educational groups and museums. By demonstrating the relevance of our past to the present, he has encouraged many to explore the activities and events of our forefathers more carefully.

He has received research fellowships from the American Philosophical Society and from the National Endowment for the Humanities to Yale University and Chicago's Newberry Library Family and Community History Center, Memberships include the Organization of American Historians, Historical Society of Michigan, American Society for Eighteenth Century Studies, Michigan and Saginaw historical associations and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. He resides in Saginaw's historic district with his wife, Diane and two children.

## JOHN R. BROADFOOT

John R. Broadfoot joined Saginaw Valley State College in July of 1968 as an Admissions Counselor. While on campus, he also served as Coordinator of Adult Education, Director of Continuing Education, Evening Services Administrator, and Assistant Director for the Division of Placement and Continuing Education. He retired in July of 1980.

Mr. Broadfoot was one of the first students at Saginaw Valley College when it opened in September of 1964 with 88 part time and 12 full time students. He attended classes part time while working full time, and in 1967, at the age of 48, Mr. Broadfoot made the headlines when he received his B.A.: the Saginaw News read "Ten Receive B.A. Degrees."

This second baccalaureate degree came nearly 30 years after his first from the Ohio College of Chiropody. Since that time, Broadfoot completed his Mas-

ter's degree at Central Michigan University and Doctorate coursework in Educational Administration at the University of Michigan.

He is a member of the Natioanl University Extension Association, Michigan Coordinating Council for Continuing Higher Education, and serves on the SVSC Landee Award Committee and SVSC Alumni Association. Mr. Broadfoot has been very active in the Jaycees, American Legion, United Way and the Rotary Club. He and his wife, Helen, currently live in Traverse City.

Following a code adopted by the Intercollegiate Commission in New York City in 1895 and used by more American colleges and universities, our graduates today are wearing gowns made of black material. Sleeves on the gowns of bachelor's degree recipients are long and pointed, while master's degree gowns have long sleeves which are closed at the bottom.

Hoods, made of the same acetate material as the gown, are lined in cardinal red with the second school color—blue—indicated by the chevron. In addition, the colored velvet or velveteen edging on the hood designates the department or faculty from which the degree was issued.
