

CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES



NED S. ARBURY DOCTOR OF LAWS

Ned S. Arbury, president of A. S. Arbury & Sons insurance firm, is a native of Midland. He earned his Bachelor of Arts and Master of Science degrees from the University of Michigan, and states he is "still learning." He is president of International Loss Adjusting and was chairman of the former Panax Corporation. He is also director and a founder of Ultra Carbon Corporation of Michigan and Texas.

Arbury has long been active in community affairs and is a past director and president of the Midland Chamber of Commerce, and holds memberships in Michigan and U. S. Chambers of Commerce. Currently he chairs the Business Industry Scan Committee of the Midland County Economic Development Corporation. He also chairs the Anti-Drunk Driving Alliance of Midland (ADDAM) and heads an informal group

which encourages area youth possessing leadership qualities to enter politics.

He is a founder of the Midland County Cancer Society, chairman of the Pardee Cancer Treatment Committee, past officer of the United Cancer Council, and president of Health Resources, Inc. In addition, Arbury has served on the Presidential Task Force, a congressional leadership committee and the National Right to Work Legal Defense Council, and is a member of the Capitol Hill Club. He also holds memberships in the Midland Rotary Club and the Saginaw Valley Torch Club. His wife, Dorothy (Honey), is a member of SVSC's Board of Control. They reside in Midland.



MAURICE HARARI DOCTOR OF HUMANITIES

Dr. Maurice Harari is vice president for international programs for the American Association of State Colleges and Universities. He is a pioneer in the advancement of international education programs in several nations, and has participated in educational missions in Africa, Latin America, Western Europe, U.S.S.R., Republic of China, Pakistan, Turkey, and Asia.

Dr. Harari currently assists colleges and universities to internationalize their curriculum and develop intercultural programs on campus and overseas. In 1982 he was project director of the National Endowment for the Humanities-supported faculty development institute on "Islam, the Middle East and World Politics." A former college academic administrator and political science professor, Harari taught courses

in international affairs and Third World problems. He has handled negotiations and contract administration with U.S. and foreign governmental agencies, universities and other institutions, and has served as a consultant to develop international/intercultural education programs for government and private-sector agencies.

Among his publications are "Global Dimensions in U.S. Education: the University," and "Internationalizing the Curriculum and the Campus." He served as trustee of the Global Development and Studies Institute, program executive for Ford Foundation's International Training and Research Division, and was on the Dartmouth College faculty. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Columbia College, and a Ph.D. from Columbia University. His home is in McLean, Virginia.

HERBERT H. LYON DOCTOR OF LAWS

Herbert H. Lyon is a senior consultant for The Dow Chemical Company and a former member of the Board of Directors of the firm. He is also active with its compensation and audit committees.

Lyon is a native of Midland, and received a Bachelor of Arts degree at Wayne State University. He also is a graduate of the Advanced Management Program of the Harvard Business School.

A veteran of World War II, Lyon joined Dow in 1947 in Midland. He became controller of the former Madison (Illinois) Division in 1951. He served as a plant manager at Madison from 1958 to 1962, then returned to Midland in 1962 and was named controller of the company.

Lyon has served as a member of Dow's executive, finance, audit, compensation, and investment policy committees. He was formerly a vice president of

the company, and for several years served as its director of corporate administration.

A director of Wolohan Lumber Company, Chemical Financial Corporation and several of its subsidiaries, Lyon holds memberships in the Midland Rotary Club and Saginaw Valley Torch Club. In 1981 he was named director emeritus of Midland Hospital Center after 14 years' service on the hospital's board of directors. In 1974 he served on the Search and Screen Committee for the second president of Saginaw Valley State College.

Lyon and his wife, Antoinette, reside in Midland.

THE 1982-83 FRANC A. LANDEE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING



TERRY ISHIHARA PROFESSOR OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

Terry Ishihara is SVSC's 1982-83 recipient of the Landee Award for Excellence in Teaching. A professor of mechanical engineering and technology, he joined the SVSC faculty in 1980 and currently serves on the College Curriculum Committee in addition to his teaching duties.

Born in Ogden, Utah, Ishihara earned his Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering from Washington State University. He also received certification in mathematics education from the University of California-Berkeley, a Master of Science in applied mathematics from San Jose State University, and Master of Science and Ph.D. degrees in mechanical engineering from the University of Arizona.

SVSC's Landee Award is not the first citation Ishihara has received for teaching excellence. While teaching at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, he received the Outstanding Teacher Award from Triangle Fraternity in 1974. As a faculty member at the University of Missouri, he was cited for outstanding service to engineering students in 1969. He is a member of Tau Beta Pi engineering honorary and Pi Mu Epsilon mathematics honorary societies. His professional memberships include American Association for the Advancement of Science, American Association of University Professors, American Society for Engineering Education, and American Society of Mechanical Engineers.

His publications include a classified report on nuclear reactor heated fluid flow, "Applications of the Calculus of Variations to Aircraft Performance," "Chebyshev Polynomial Curve Fitting Technique for Strain Gage Applications," "Generation of Suboptimal, Closed Loop Guidance for Minimum Time Aircraft Trajectories," and articles on "Acceleration Measurement and Accelerometers," co-authored with Roger C. Duffield, published in McGraw-Hill Encyclopedia of Science and Technology, 1971.

He and his wife, Simi, are the parents of five children. They reside in Saginaw Township with their youngest son, Terry, who is an honor student at SVSC.

1983 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD



DENNIS E. HENSLEY

Dennis E. Hensley earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in English from SVSC in 1969. After leaving SVSC, Hensley served two years in Viet Nam as an Army sergeant before completing a Master of Arts in English from Central Michigan University. He later received a Ph.D. in English from Ball State University. He also holds an Associate in Arts degree from Delta College.

A successful writer and speaker, Hensley considers himself a "positive workaholic." His career in journalism includes general reporting and special columns for "The Muncie Star" (Indiana), as well as free lance articles for 25 major newspapers. He was a regional correspondent for the Fort Wayne "News Sentinel" from 1978 to 1982, and has written more than 700 articles published in over 50 major magazines.

Hensley served as an instructor of English at Ball State University during 1976-77, was skills advancement coordinator at Indiana Vocational Technical College in 1977-78, and director of publications for Manchester College, North Manchester, Indiana, from 1978 to 1982. During this time, he also pursued a career in journalism and frequently spoke to groups throughout the U.S. His techniques for managing a busy but well-balanced life are described in his book titled "Staying Ahead of Time." Other books he has authored include "Jack London Masterplots," "Positive Workaholism," and "Jack London's Real and Fictional Women."

He is the only reporter to gain in-depth interviews with the mother of Reverend Jim Jones after the Guyana tragedy. He also received an exclusive interview with Dr. Ralph Honzik, M.D., the campus physician at Kent State during the 1970 riots.

In a poll of writers' conference directors, editors and publishers taken by "The Christian Writer" Hensley was chosen the most dynamic speaker and teacher of the 1981-82 conference season. He was named the outstanding doctoral graduate in English at Ball State in 1982 and cited as outstanding alumnus of Bay City's T.L. Handy High School the same year. Hensley also earned six medals in Viet Nam, including the Bronze Star.

His wife, Rose, is a 1970 graduate of SVSC; a brother, Gary A., graduated from SVSC in 1973; and his sister, Pamela, earned her B.B.A. from SVSC in 1978. Residents of Fort Wayne, Indiana, the Hensleys are the parents of two children.

Following a code adopted by the Intercollegiate Commission in New York City in 1895 and used by more American colleges and universities, our graduates today are wearing gowns made of black material. Sleeves on the gowns of bachelor's degree recipients are long and pointed, while master's degree gowns have long sleeves which are closed at the bottom.

Hoods, made of the same acetate material as the gown, are lined in cardinal red with the second school color—blue—indicated by the chevron. In addition, the colored velvet or velveteen edging on the hood designates the department or faculty from which the degree was issued.
