MARY GOLDSWORTHY ARNOLD DOCTOR OF FINE ARTS

Mary Goldsworthy Arnold has long been active in community arts programs. She has served on the board of directors of the Midland Center for the Arts (MCFTA) since 1966. For 20 years she was chairman of the Midland Community Concert Society of MCFTA, and she is a former member of the board of the Midland Symphony Orchestra Society.

An accomplished organist, Mrs. Arnold served for 35 years as director of music at the Memorial Presbyterian Church in Midland, and is now Director Emeritus. She was a member of the planning committee of the Church Music Workshop at Michigan State University for many years, and is a member and former dean of the Saginaw Valley Chapter of the American Guild of Organists.

In 1975 Mrs. Arnold received the Midland Musician of the Year award from the Midland Music Society. She has been a member and former president of the Midland Community Affairs Council, and is president of the Charles J. Strosacker Foundation of Midland.

Mrs. Arnold earned a Bachelor of Music degree from Baldwin-Wallace College, Berea, Ohio, and was a teacher of piano and organ for many years. She received an Honorary Doctor of Fine Arts degree from Baldwin-Wallace College in 1971 and has been a member of the school's Board of Trustees since 1974.

Her memberships include Midland Country Club, Twentieth Century Club, Chippewa Nature Center, and Midland King's Daughters and Sons. She is married to James B. Arnold, retired chemical engineer from The Dow Chemical Company.



REP. JAMES E. O'NEILL, JR. DOCTOR OF LAWS

James E. O'Neill, Jr. represents Michigan's 85th District. He attended Saginaw public and parochial schools before receiving an A.B. degree in English and political science from Central Michigan University. He completed a Master of Fine Arts in school administration at the University of Michigan.

After three years of classroom teaching, O'Neill served as elementary and junior high principal for ten years. During this period, he held positions as vice-president and president of the Saginaw County Elementary and Junior High School Principals' Association.


First elected to the House of Representatives in 1966, O'Neill has been re-elected eight times. He served as Demo-

cratic Personnel Director in the House, and as Democratic Majority Whip.

He was a member of the Education Commission of the United States, and was appointed to the Educational Block Grant Advisory Committee in 1982. Currently O'Neill is chairman of the Subcommittee on K-12 and Department of Education of the House Appropriations Committee. He also is chairman of the Joint Committee on Capital Outlay, and a member of the House Appropriations Committee.

O'Neill is a member of St. Stephen's Catholic Church, American Legion Post 439, Saginaw Fordney Club, Saginaw Pioneer Club, St. Mary's Cathedral Athletic Association, Brothers of Kosciuzko Pulaski Club, Germania Club of Saginaw, and the Tri-County Irish American Club. He has two children, Margaret Ruth and James E. O'Neill III.

THE 1983-84 FRANC A. LANDEE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING



THOMAS J. RENNA PROFESSOR OF HISTORY

Dr. Thomas J. Renna, professor of history, has been cited by various state and national organizations for his accomplishments as a teacher and scholar. However, Renna says the Landee citation carries special significance for him because it reinforces his belief that teaching students to enjoy learning is an important challenge.

Dr. Renna's students and former students agree that he is a challenging instructor. Many credit him for their love of the learning process itself; the acquisition of new experiences and new ideas simply for their own sake. Other students claim that Renna expected them to do more than they thought they could -- and usually with positive results. He has used a variety of approaches to teach history. His presentations included slides, research material, related

books, primary data, and some very innovative techniques. Such techniques have included Renna coming to class attired in a Roman toga, reciting the lines of Julius Caesar.

Earlier this month Renna was named one of two SVSC professors to receive the Michigan Association of Governing Boards Award. The citation is given to faculty from each of the State's 15 public colleges and universities to give recognition to the best teachers in Michigan's higher education system.

In 1983 he was the recipient of the Michigan Academy of Arts, Science and Letters award. Only one such award is given annually to a scholar from Michigan, in any academic field, for outstanding contributions to original scholarship. Renna has received numerous grants, including awards from the National Endowment for the Humanities and the American Philosophical Society.

Renna has been listed in the Directory of American Scholars, Outstanding Educators of America, Men of Achievement, and the Dictionary of International Biography. He is the author of two books, over 30 articles on European history in professional journals, and numerous book reviews. He currently is writing a book on the conceptual history of Jerusalem. Since 1973 he has delivered more than 60 scholarly papers before historical organizations.

In 1983 Renna was invited to present a paper at Haifa University in Israel, and he conducted research at Hebrew University in Jerusalem. Based on his study in Israel, he has developed slide/lecture programs titled "Jerusalem: Crossroad of Faiths and of Political Turmoil."

Renna earned a Bachelor of Arts in history and philosophy from the University of Scranton. He earned a Master of Arts from the University of Nebraska and a Ph.D. from Brown University. In 1970 he joined SVSC's faculty, and he resides in Saginaw Township with his wife and three children.

DENNIS O'CONNOR, D.O.

Dr. Dennis O'Connor graduated from Saginaw Valley State College in 1975 with a Bachelor of Science in pre-medicine. O'Connor was born in Detroit, but grew up on a farm near Caro. Following graduation from Millington High School and Delta College, he served a four-year apprenticeship as an electrician and worked for Chevrolet Motor Car Division of General Motors for 15 years before enrolling as a full-time student at SVSC. In 1978 he received a Doctor of Osteopathy degree from Michigan State University.

From September 1978 to September 1979 O'Connor interned at Saginaw Osteopathic Hospital before opening a private practice in Freeland. He now maintains an office in Hemlock.

O'Connor is a physician with a strong commitment to community service, a broad range of interests, and a belief that

education is a lifelong process. His interests are varied, and include a major in English in addition to the pre-medical curriculum in the sciences. He is an avid fan of SVSC Cardinal athletic teams. As an outgrowth of that interest, O'Connor has volunteered his services as team physician for SVSC. He serves as physician in charge at home football games and holds clinics on campus, dividing his Wednesdays between SVSC's training room and the College Health Services office open to all students.

In addition, O'Connor provides free physicals each year for nearly 400 athletes participating in SVSC sports. He offers discounts on medical care and medications to aid SVSC students in cutting medical costs, and conducts inexpensive clinics rather than requiring office calls.

O'Connor also has donated his services as physician for Golden Gloves and other amateur fights. He is president of the Saginaw Valley Amateur Radio Association, and trustee for the local Repeated for radio communications. He serves as department head of general practice at Saginaw Osteopathic Hospital, as well as holding staff positions at Midland Hospital Center and St. Luke's Hospital.

Along with his wife, Char, O'Connor has been an active fund raiser for SVSC athletics. Another of their projects, "Take an Athlete to Dinner Program," pairs college athletes with area professional people. The O'Connors feel these contacts can inspire students in career aspirations, as well as demonstrating the importance of community involvement.

In keeping with his belief that learning is a lifelong process, O'Connor recently explored his artistic abilities in a painting class at SVSC. He also holds a pilot's license, and he enjoys sailing.

GRADUATION ATTIRE

Following a code adopted by the Intercollegiate Commission in New York City in 1895 and used by more American colleges and universities, our graduates today are wearing gowns made of black material. Sleeves on the gowns of bachelor's degree recipients are long and pointed, while master's degree gowns have long sleeves which are closed at the bottom.

Hoods, made of the same acetate material as the gown, are lined in cardinal red with the second school color—blue—indicated by the chevron. In addition, the colored velvet or velveteen edging on the hood designates the department or faculty from which the degree was issued.
