At this point, what is happening to:

(a) Walden?

The treaty talks are progressing but now seems to be approaching even further. He is barely keeping one step ahead of the unknown assassin. He fears for his life. He is becoming estranged from his wife. He cannot understand his daughter's rebellion.

(b) Lydia?

She is falling in love with Felix again. She is terrified that the secret of Charlotte's passage will come out. She is torn between saving Oliver and saving Charlotte. She is loving her husband.

(c) Charlotte?

Her rebellion is at peak. She is falling in love with Oliver? She is getting to know Felix. She is consoling at Oliver's kidnapping / murder.

(d) Felix?

He is getting closer to Oliver. He is using Charlotte. He is fighting his love for Lydia. He is frightened of Walden. He's not sure he's doing right.
