Dr. Samuel D. Marble resigned today as President of Saginaw Valley College. He submitted his letter of resignation this morning to Charles B. Curtiss, Chairman of the SVC Board of Control.

The resignation ends 16 years of building higher education in this area for Dr. Marble. He was the first President and organizer of Delta College. In 1964 he became the first president of Saginaw Valley College, and built this college from scratch.

The Board of Control will consider the resignation Monday, January 14th.
