THE INTERIOR

The Board of Control toured the campus last night, viewing recent construction work, and then met in the Learning Center, Room 15, and took the following action:

Approved a year's leave of absence without pay for Dr. Daniel Nussbaum, who is doing work for the Department of Defense in Washington, D.C.; and a leave of absence without pay during Winter 1975 for Dr. Hsuan Chen, who will be studying computer science at Michigan State University.

Named Dr. Benjamin Okwumabua assistant professor of management.

Mrs. Ann Dickey reported that Admissions are still on the rise. A report issued at the end of July showed that SVC had received 1312 applications for fall semester, an increase of 46.1 per cent over the 898 applications received this time last year. Tri-County applications have increased 51 per cent; and transfer student applications are up 25.5 per cent.

Mrs. Dickey noted a slight decrease in the pre-registration count for the upcoming fall semester, which she said is due to continuing freshmen orientation during the month of August and a previous accelerated graduation rate, with the college registering less seniors this year.

Dr. James reported on an off-campus program in Midland, where SVC, Central Michigan University, and Delta College are cooperating to offer business programs. Delta offers the lower-level courses, with CMU and SVC offering the upper-level courses.

The 1974-75 budget was not complete for action by the Board.

Approved a contract with the Bay-Arenac Intermediate School District and the Bay County Board of Commissioners to provide educational responsibilities for the Bay County Juvenile Home. George Kallos will supervise this program as he does the program at the Saginaw County Juvenile Center. Kallos will be aided by four teaching fellows working in the Master of Arts in Teaching program.

Approved the release of \$43,000 in development funds to supplement the Engineering and Technology program's 1974-75 budget.
