NOTE:

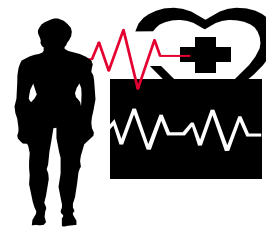
Zahnow Library's online databases are available to SVSU students, faculty and staff from off-campus locations.
