



(SFX[®] link resolver by ExLibris[™] Group)

What is it?

Find Text is a library service using SFX link resolver software by ExLibris Group that links periodical citations from one database to the full text article (if available) in another database, as well as to other library services available to the SVSU community.

How Do I Use Find Text ?

Use **Find Text** to

- ⇒ **Link to the full text of periodical articles through many of our databases (if SVSU has access to the full text).**

After searching a database, if the article you want to read is not available in full text, click on the **Find Text** button. It will probably look like this:



In some cases, there will only be a link that says “**Find this article for me!**” or both the button and the link will be present.

A new window will then open that will list the options (called SFX services) available for that article. It might look something like this (the menu changes according to what you are looking for—there might be more or fewer selections):

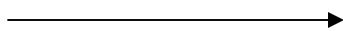

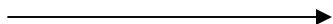

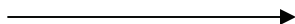
