

Eric R. Gilbertson Hall



Eric R. Gilbertson Hall is named in recognition of SVSU's third and longest serving president. During his tenure student enrollment grew by 85%, the physical campus tripled in size and endowments increased more than twenty-fold to exceed \$70 million. The center piece of this expansion was the Regional Education Center. It was the first educational building constructed north of College Drive. In 2010 it was connected to the second building on "north" campus, the Health and Human Services building. It was renamed Gilbertson Hall in the fall of 2014. It is home to the College of Education and Ott Auditorium.
