

Health & Human Services

Construction of the State of Michigan funded Health & Human Services building allowed for the consolidation of the departments of kinesiology, occupational therapy and social work with the Crystal M. Lange College of Nursing into the new College of Health and Human Services. It was the second major educational building constructed north of College Drive and the second LEED certified building on campus.

First opened in 2010, it was designed by the Bloomfield Hills based architectural firm TMP Associates and constructed by longtime Saginaw contractor Spence Brothers.
