

# Student Center

The Student Center building was built in response to a quickly expanding on-campus student population associated with the increased availability of on campus housing. It is currently home to student government, student organizations, residential life, and the ***Richard Thompson Student Activities Center***. First opened in 2003, it was designed by Saginaw based Wigen-Tincknell-Meyer (now Wigen Tincknell Associates) and constructed by Saginaw contractor Wolgast Corporation.
