The Student Center building was built in response to a quickly expanding oncampus student population associated with the increased availability of on campus housing. It is currently home to student government, student organizations. residential life, and the Richard **Thompson Student Activities Center.** First opened in 2003, it was designed by Saginaw based Wigen-Tincknell-Meyer (now Wigen Tincknell Associates) and constructed by Saginaw contractor Wolgast Corporation.
