Title	<i>Hybridation Overlap of Chemistry and Poetry Orbitals</i>
Abstract	Chemistry and Poetry may at first seem to be immiscible academic endeavors. They had in the past enjoyed periods of co-existence, especially so in alchemical times, when laboratory protocol was by necessity often shrouded in ambiguity. Noted 20th century chemists Roald Hoffmann and Primo Levi are perhaps most responsible for once again bringing the disciplines. In examples taken from his own poetry the speaker will describe how poetic form can enrich the college student's chemical experience.
