Composition - ENG 111
Reading - Test at SVSU
Mathematics - MAT 104 (no transferable credit)

Additional Basic Skills courses may be required depending on placement test results and/or transfer credits.

GENERAL EDUCATION - The following are Mid-Michigan Community College courses that may be used to satisfy or partially satisfy the 10 General Education categories at SVSU. The guide may include courses that are currently inactive at Mid-Michigan Community College, but that may appear on student transcripts. Please contact SVSU for inactive courses not included on this guide.

4. **Natural Sciences** (7 cr. from two **SVSU** departments, including one lab science course) – **BIO** 101, 131, 135, 141, 142, 201, 202, 203, 221; **CHM** 111; **ENV** 210; **GEL** 101, 112; **PHY** 101, 103, 105, 211; **PSC** 101, 102; **SCI** 200 [CI]
5. **History/Philosophy** (3 cr.) – **HIS** 101, 102, 211, 212, 251, 252; **PHL** 201, 220
6. **Social Sciences** (3 cr.) – **ANT** 170; **ECO** 110; **PSY** 101
7. **Social Institutions** (3 cr.) – **BUS** 153; **ECO** 201; **LEN** 205; **POL** 201; **SOC** 101, 250; **SSC** 200 [CI]
8. **International Systems** (3 cr.) – **BUS** 225; **HUM** 183; **POL** 250
9. **Oral Communication** (3 cr.) - **FRN** 101, 102; **GER** 101, 102; **JPN** 101, 102; **NAL** 101; **SPE** 101, 251, 257, 261; **SPN** 101, 102, 201
10. **Written Communication** (3 cr.) – **ENG** 222

Saginaw Valley State University's General Education requirements also include two Communication Intensive courses selected from Categories 2 - 8. Additional course information may be required for transfer credit evaluation.

No courses may be counted in more than one General Education category but may be counted toward majors and minors.

Please note-Category 4 requires a minimum of two **SVSU** departments.
