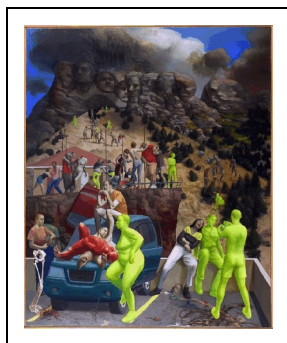

Artist Reception: Thursday, November 13, 4:00 pm - 7:00 pm

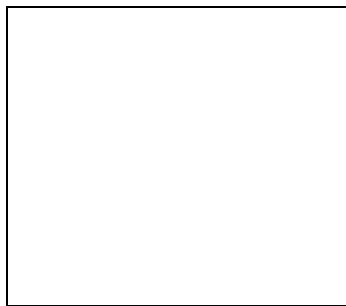

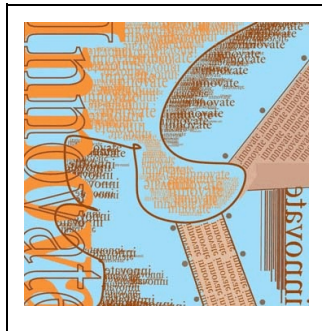

Jessica Gondek is from Montgomery Illinois, a western community outside of Chicago. Ms. Gondek has a M.F.A. degree

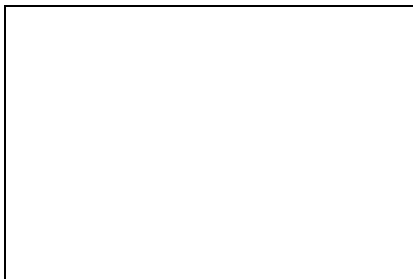
