



**Andy Rishmawi** just completed his third season at the helm of the men's soccer team at Saginaw Valley State University. Rishmawi's overall record at SVSU after three seasons is 23-32-3 (.396). In 2008, SVSU advanced to the GLIAC championship game. The Cardinals had their best

season in program history in 2007, finishing with a record of 11-8-1 overall and 6-3-1 in the GLIAC, good for third in the conference and a berth into the GLIAC Conference Tournament. Four different players were named to All-GLIAC teams, including First Team selections Jimmy Henry and Kevin Fox. The team was 4-14 during Rishmawi's inaugural season and the program looks toward the future with promise. Rishmawi graduated from Flushing High School in 1994 and then Saginaw Valley in 1999. He has two masters degrees, a masters in education and a masters in administration. Rishmawi was the head coach of Saginaw Nouvel Boy's team in 1999, Trenton Boys and Girls team in 2000, Davison Boys team in 2001, and then Flushing Boy's and Girl's in 2002 to present.

Rishmawi still is the women's varsity soccer coach at Flushing and teaches at Flushing High School. He has been a trainer for various clubs during the years. His overall High School coaching record is 147-62-15. He played soccer for Saginaw Valley State University and was the captain for three years and All-GLIAC for three years. During college he was able to train with the Mid-Michigan Bucks and Grand Rapids Explosion and Real Espana in Honduras. Andy and his wife, Debbie, reside in Flushing with sons Aaron and Owen.

## June 25-28 Individual's Camp

Boys High School Sophomores - Incoming  
College Freshman  
Fee: \$265 resident / \$215 commuter

The camp will allow players to showcase themselves and get exposure to the collegiate game as well. The week will consist of fitness tests, training sessions, scrimmages, and individual skills test. The objective is to expose players to what it is like to be a collegiate soccer player and what it takes to make it at the collegiate level. Players will also be evaluated during the week and be recommended as to areas they need to improve upon and where they have the best opportunity of playing at the collegiate level.

On-site registration is from noon to 1 p.m. on June 25. The camp runs from 8 a.m. - 9 p.m. daily. Check out on June 28 at 1 p.m. All participants receive a free T-shirt.

## July 9-12 Team Camp

Fee: \$265 resident / \$215 commuter

*The camp is designed to deliver immediate and powerful results!*

We will work with the coaches to implement and teach the formation best suited for the team and develop strategies to achieve goals. Daily sessions will also teach vital skills and fundamentals of sound and productive soccer. Field training sessions and strategy sessions will take place between games and in the evenings. Teams will get scrimmages daily against other teams participating in the team camp to practice skills, formations, and strategies learned daily. All games are videotaped and analyzed by the coaches of the SVSU Men's soccer teams. Our coaching staff will determine each team's strengths and weaknesses.

On-site registration is from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on July 9. The camp runs from 8 a.m.- 9 p.m. daily. Check out on July 12 at 1 p.m.

Resident Teams may have 1 coach attend at no cost. Each additional coach is \$100. Resident Teams must have at least 1 coach stay in the Residence Hall each night. Commuter Teams may have 1 coach attend at no cost. Each additional coach is \$50.

**Payment:** To secure a spot in the individual camps, please include a \$50 non-refundable deposit. Registrations that are turned in on the first day of the camp will still receive a free T-shirt.

**Camp Facilities:**

- Instruction and games will be conducted on our soccer fields and in the Ryder Center.
- The pool will be available during designated hours.

**Medical Facilities:** An athletic trainer will be readily available throughout the camp.

**Food:** The first meal on the first day of camp will be a pizza party for both residents and commuters. Residents will receive breakfast, lunch and dinner on full days. Commuters will receive lunch and dinner. The last meal served for residents will be breakfast on the last day of camp.

**Check Out and Departure Procedure:** Room inspection: key turn-in upon check out. There is a lost key charge of \$35. Parents may pick up their children at the residence hall following the awards ceremony at noon.

**Equipment Needs:** Soccer cleats, indoor shoes/ tennis shoes and shin guards.

**Room Assignments:** There must be mutual consent when requesting a roommate. Campers will be housed in the college residence suites and be divided between boys' and girls' suites. Supervision will be provided in the residence halls by camp counselors and the coaching staff.
