

DIRECTOR OF SUMMER CAMPS...



Drago Dumbovic just completed his sixth season on the bench of the Saginaw Valley State women's soccer team. Under his guidance, the Cardinals have compiled an overall record of 43-31-3 (.558) and are 20-16-1 (.541) in the GLIAC. The Cardinals finished 2007 with a 9-5-1 mark and were 4-3-1 in the conference which was good for fourth place. SVSU made the second

round of the GLIAC Tournament, defeating Ferris State in a home contest in the semifinal round. The Cardinals placed four student-athletes on the All-GLIAC teams in 2006, highlighted by Stephanie Roy being named First Team All-GLIAC. Roy also was named to the NSCAA Great Lakes All-Region team becoming the first female soccer player to earn that honor at SVSU. Saginaw Valley State finished a school-best third in the conference standings in 2005 and started the season 6-0 in the GLIAC before finishing 6-2. Three Cardinals were named to the All-GLIAC team under Drago's direction in 2005. The 2004 squad finished the year 9-4 and had a 5-3 record in the GLIAC. Over the past three seasons, SVSU soccer has enjoyed their best stretch in school history compiling a 29-16-1 record and a 16-8 GLIAC record.

Dumbovic opened Drago's Sports Plex and Drago's Soccer Academy of Excellence located in Midland in 2001. Prior to owning his businesses, Drago was head coach of the Detroit Rockers from 1999-2001 and served as an assistant coach for the Rockers during the 1998-99 campaign. Drago started his professional career of 23 years in his beloved country with Dinamo Zagreb where he was part of one of the best teams in club history. Drago came to the United States in 1983 and became an immediate fan favorite with his extraordinary skills and love for children and his community.

Drago played professional soccer from 1983 to 1999 for several teams including the Detroit Rockers and Detroit Neon. He was named an all-star six times and set several new league records during his playing career. He also won an NPSL Championship with the Detroit Rockers in 1992. Born in Croatia, he started playing soccer professionally at the age of 16 in Yugoslavia.

Drago has also worked as a volunteer for various children's programs and charities around the country, and has appeared at more than 300 schools around the country as a motivational speaker.

BASA Soccer Fields • Ages U5 – U14

Fee: \$65

The Saginaw Valley State University day-camp provides an opportunity for players of all levels to enjoy the great game of soccer. In this camp players will learn the fundamentals of the game and how to implement those skills in the tactical game of soccer. The camp is designed to get youth players experiencing the game of soccer in a positive and fun environment.

The camp will run from 5:30 to 7:00 daily. On site registration is at 4:30 pm. All participants receive a free T-shirt. Registrations postmarked by May 22 will receive a free soccer ball as well.

July 20-23 • Individual – CO-ED/Overnight

Ages U9 – U14

Fee: Overnight Camp: \$299/ Commuter: \$199

We are combining two very popular camps into one to create an exceptional positive & fun environment.

This program was developed for dedicated players who never stop striving to reach their full potential.

The program concentrates on providing a positive environment for talented, elite players to further develop their skills and understanding of how to implement learned skills into the tactical game of soccer. July 24-26 • Tournament Plus/Team Camp

Girl's High School and Club Teams

Fee: \$265 for residents / \$215 for commuters.

The camp is designed to deliver immediate and powerful results!

Tournament: 4 team tournament; 3 games guaranteed; same level of competition.

Plus: All games are videotaped and analyzed by the coaches of the SVSU Women's soccer teams. Our coaching staff will determine each team's strengths and weaknesses; the formation best suited for the team and

develop strategies to achieve goals. Field training sessions and strategy sessions will take place between games and in the evenings.

On-site registration is from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. The camp runs from 8 a.m. - 9p.m. daily. Check out on July 26 at 1 p.m. All participants receive a free T-shirt Registrations postmarked by June 24 will receive a free soccer ball as well.

Soccer Camp Information

Facts: There are three different camps for each appropriate age group, one for groups U5 through U8, another for age groups U9 through U14, and one for girl's high school students. (Varsity and Junior Varsity)

Soccer ball can be purchased at registration for \$10

Payment: To secure a spot in the individual camps, please include a \$50 non-refundable deposit. For the Bay City Soccer Camp, please enclose a \$35 non-refundable deposit. Registrations that are turned in on the first day of the camp will receive a free T-shirt.

Camp Facilities:

- Instruction and games will be conducted on our soccer fields and in the Ryder Center.
- The pool will be available during designated hours.
- A camp store will be open throughout the camp.

Medical Facilities: An athletic trainer will be readily available throughout the camp.

Food: The initial meal on the first day of the day and individual camp is lunch (dinner at the girl's high school camp). The last meal served on the last day of camp will be breakfast. Campers who will be staying at SVSU for the overnight and girl's high school camp will receive breakfast, lunch and dinner on full days. For campers who are commuters, lunch is included in both individual and team camps.

Check Out and Departure Procedure: Room inspection: key turn-in upon check out. There is a lost key charge of \$35. Parents may pick up their children at the residence hall following lunch and awards ceremony at 1 p.m.

Equipment Needs: Soccer cleats, indoor shoes/ tennis shoes and shin guards.

Room Assignments: There must be mutual consent when requesting a roommate. Campers will be housed in the college residence suites and be divided between boys' and girls' suites. Supervision will be provided in the residence halls by camp counselors and the coaching staff.
