Established in 1995, this festival was designated “The Official Shakespeare Festival of the State of Michigan” by the governor and senate in 2003. It is housed on the campus of Jackson Community college and its high-quality performances feature local and professional actors, including Equity performers.

■ We will enjoy a 2 p.m. matinee performance of the romantic comedy *All's Well That Ends Well*. This play offers captivating themes of male versus female, society's view of merit and rank, and the value of honor and integrity.

■ Prior to the show, we will visit the Ella Sharp Museum of Art & History which expanded to five galleries in 2006, including the 1,000 square foot Andrews Gallery of Wildlife Art. There are also historic buildings, galleries and a gift shop.

■ Our lunch will be catered by the museum's restaurant, Ella's Granary which features soups, salads and sandwiches.
