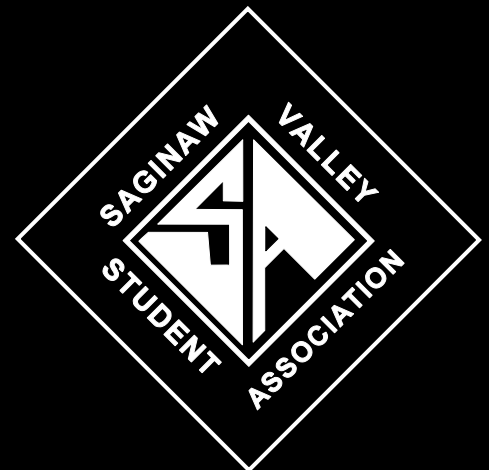

The Agenda was approved as presented.

Officer Reports

President Kanine informed the Association that they were recognized as the organization of the month by NRHH. He also spoke about a request made by the Office of Diversity Programs for two students to sit on the committee for Martin Luther King Day.

Speaker Griffin passed around the list of office hours and had each representative to make sure that they are correct.

EAA Duncan reported on what to do with checks and SVPOs as they come into the office.

Parliamentarian Boon talked about the Know your Rights campaign that will take place between 11 AM and 4 PM on between Monday, October 19, 2009 and Thursday, October 22, 2009. She also talked about a panel discussion that will take place about the same topic on October 22, 2009 at 7:30 PM in the MPR. She announced that she will be attending the Kochville Township meeting on this coming Tuesday. Julie Boon and Bethany Freer will be attending the SAM meeting this weekend at Grand Valley. SAM will be held at SVSU in November.

Ombudsman Curtis announced that his committee is working on hosting another "Last Lecture" series. His committee is also working on having a Halloween party that focuses on safe choices.

Organizational Director Volante commented on the first RSO Presidents meeting. The workshop will be on Friday, October 23, 2009 at 1 PM. He announced the new posting policy (that only 10 posters can be posted on campus per event), and said that his committee will work on helping to alter this policy. He talked about a new e-mail policy where a person can type an organization's name in the "To" spot and it will send to all of the officers of that group.

Allocations Director Grimaldi announced that we have allocated over \$5,000 so far this year. Study Abroad winter scholarships are due this Friday, October 16, 2009 and will be voted on at the October 19 meeting. Allocations meetings will be held at 8:30 PM each Monday night.

An 80's dance may also take place sometime in November. Finally, Cardinal Feud prizes are in, so representatives can hand them out as people come in to collect them. The committee will meet next Tuesday.
