

CETL is pleased to announce that SVSU will be increasing its compensation rates for all adjunct faculty, effective in January 2023.

SVSU Adjunct Faculty Pay Scale

Additional raises will affect faculty who teach the following kinds of courses:

- For faculty who teach English 080, English 111, a General Education Category Ten course, a General Education Category One course, or a Communication Intensive General Education course, the new compensation rate will be \$875/credit hour.
- For faculty who lead lecture classes with a cap of 50 or more students, the new compensation rate will be \$875/credit hour. (This pay only applies to those who are responsible for the entire class and is not available to those faculty who assist other faculty with large class sizes, nor does it include those faculty who teach labs or recitations stemming from large classes.)

Stipends for participation in a workshop will increase to \$50 for a single workshop and \$100 for a full-day workshop.

Finally, faculty whose mileage from their home address to campus is between 50 and 75 miles will be compensated at the rate of \$450 per course. Faculty whose mileage from their home address to campus is 76 or more miles will be compensated \$600 per course. (This increase takes effect during the fall 2022 semester.)

Credit for this good news should go to former CETL Director Dawn Hinton and Betsy Diegel (Special Assistant to the Provost), who listened to your concerns and then developed a comprehensive proposal to raise adjunct faculty compensation. The proposal's quick acceptance indicates, I believe, the value SVSU puts on your commitment to making our students successful. For all you do, thank you.
