Science East was constructed in 2001 as part of the state funded project: Instructional Facility #3 (IF-3), which also included a major renovation of Science West.

Upon completion in 2001 Science East, along with the renovated Science West building were dedicated as the Herbert Dow Doan Science Complex named in recognition of longtime University supporter Herbert D. "Ted" Doan.

Science East currently houses the Chemistry and Computer Science departments.
