Herbert Dow Doan Science Building

Science West is part of the Herbert Dow Doan Science Building, named in recognition of longtime University supporter Herbert D. “Ted” Doan. The 2013 greenhouse expansion is named in recognition of Arnold & Gertrude Boutell.

Science West was originally constructed in 1986 as part of the second State funded building project instructional facility #2 (IF-2). IF-2 also includes Zanhaw library and Brown Hall. Upon completion, IF-2 linked Wickes Hall to Pioneer Hall.



Currently, Science West houses the departments of biology and physics.
