

University Village

University Village was constructed in four phases beginning in 2000 and ending in 2007.

Phase 1 included a separate laundry building and two buildings that are single occupancy apartments. Phase II included a community room addition to the laundry building as well as outdoor basketball and volleyball courts. Phase III (referred to as Village East) & Phase IV (referred to as Village West) each feature a central laundry.



The typical townhouse style unit is comprised of a kitchen, bathroom and living area on the first floor with four bedrooms and a bathroom on the second floor.
