

West Complex

The fourth State funded project on campus, the Business and Professional Development Center (West Complex), was constructed in 1996. West Complex connected Doan Center on the south to Arbury Fine Arts on the north. It completed the formation of the main campus courtyard. A 2011 addition facilitated the move of the bookstore onto the first floor.



West Complex consists of Curtiss Hall which houses the College of Business and is named in recognition of former board member Charles B. Curtiss.

Groening Commons named in recognition of William A. Groening, and the Performing Arts Center. The Performing Arts Center is home to the Rhea H. Miller Recital Hall and the Malcolm Field Theatre for the Performing Arts.
