## **Experimental Research Investigator**

- Executed statistical analysis using bivariate and multivariate regressions and found no significant relationship between over-parenting and student motivation.
- Created a research project exploring cognitive dissonance in people who hold secular ideologies as well as individuals who hold religious convictions.
- Developed and operationalized a series of interview questions.
- Conducted 3 face-to-face interviews.
- Using qualitative analysis, determined that personal freedom was the most common factor in balancing secular ideologies and religious convictions.
