Currently licensed and employed as a Registered Nurse in the state of Michigan Demonstrates nursing excellence in **any one** of the award categories Can be nominated by **any colleague** (peer, supervisor, professional colleague) Saginaw Valley State University Faculty are **not** eligible.

- Submit nominations prior to the deadline of April 26, 2024. Late entries will NOT be considered.
- 2. Narrative should contain complete, concise information to support the nomination.
- 3. The selection committee will be comprised of the Nursing Excellence Committee. All nominations will be blinded to avoid possible bias.
